Hundreds of you participated in this year's online balloting to tell other military community members in mainland Japan, Okinawa, South Korea and Guam which organizations, businesses, places and people you thought were the best – and why. In doing so, you also told us a little something about what makes you the best.



We learned that those of you in mainland Japan, for example, really appreciate all your gracious host nation has to offer. While you folks on Okinawa really know how to make the most of some great off-base events and get the biggest bang for the buck. Our voters in South Korea clearly know a good deal when they see it as well as what works and what doesn't, while those of you on Guam enjoy some of the best hospitality in the Pacific.

This year we narrowed the voting categories to 20 by eliminating or consolidating some. This includes determining Best MWR/FSS by tallying the number of winning services under these organizations instead of by direct vote. Balloting was more diverse than ever.

We heard more from the Army community in Korea, its Marine counterpart on Okinawa and from a wider variety of smaller or far-flung bases in general. This resulted in stiff competition for perennial favorites, some of which were knocked out of the running entirely, and some first-time victors that are probably new to most voters.

As in past years, ballots cast by some lucky voters paid off in more ways than one. Congratulations to Mara Lackie on Yokota Air Base, Japan; Yukie Nagle with Commander Fleet Activities Okinawa on Kadena Air Base; and Jennifer Hikichi aboard Sasebo Naval Base, Japan. They won a \$300, \$200 and \$100 Exchange gift card, respectively, for voting in Best of the Pacific 2015-16!

This year's balloting has ended, but it's never too late to plug a prized service, dish out details on a great restaurant or share the scoop on the best getaway. Best of the Pacific voters on the central Japanese islands of Honshu and Kyushu clearly know that they have it good. There’s a reason why the Land of the Rising Sun has garnered the most Pacific-wide votes for best foreign country to visit for the past four years, and these voters are forever reminding us.

In past years many have indicated that they enjoy making the most of this exotic overseas duty station. This year, they also showed a penchant for the familiar - from a friendly host nation that makes you feel at home or familiar voice on the radio, to a romantic restaurant and a great place to shop. And boy, do these voters take their shopping seriously!

The Kanto Plain is home to Yokota Air Base, Yokosuka Naval Base, Naval Air Facility Atsugi and Camp Zama where most of the 51,000 U.S. troops, civilian personnel and their dependents that U.S. Forces Japan estimates are in mainland Japan reside. Such large or centrally located bases tend to dominate the ballot box and Yokota’s strong showing this year is evident in the end of Zama golf course’s more than decade-long winning streak and more.

However, voters from smaller or farther afield installations such as Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni, Misawa Air Base and even Hardy Barracks, also made sure their voices were heard.

Camp Fuji’s John Powers took time to tell us about the “great staff and good selections” at Zama ITT. Bradley Waters chimed in from Yokohama North Dock to let us know that self-service “yakniku” grilling is the best family meal out “to allow great conversation.” Similarly, Naval Base Sasebo’s John Bart helped tip the scales in favor of Aeon Mall for best off-base shopping by lauding his local branch’s “good selection of produce and fresh seafood.”

Q: What's with the nickname and if you could get a do-over what would you change it to?

A: I've been "Caz" ever since I was a child. I love my full name, Casimir, but I've always found it too formal for certain situations. With it being a very old Polish name as well, many Americans often find difficulty pronouncing it and usually call me "Cashmere," like the fabric. I just like to make things easier.

Q: How would you describe your job to an alien from another planet where there is nothing like it?

A: Well, first I'd ask, "What took you so long?" The best way I could describe being a DJ is that you're a stage actor for people who can't see. You have to put on a

show with only your voice and make friends with people you've never met and will probably never meet.

Q: What do you like most about your job?

A: Listener interaction, hands down. I've said this before both on and off air: "There is no point in listening to the radio if the DJ is just a back-up iPod." Making a connection with listeners is the key, and I try my hardest to make topics interesting and engaging for them.

Q: What's the key to being a good DJ?

A: I think the key to being a good DJ is being an overdone image of yourself. Since you're not physically with the listener, you have to make up for the lack of physical presence by being a bit dramatic sometimes. The greatest sin in radio to me is not having an opinion or coming off as disinterested to the listener. If you don't care, why should they? To put it bluntly, if you're a boring person you shouldn't be on the radio. Listeners like to be entertained, and in today's society of 4G streaming, Internet radio, iPods and the rest, you're never going to compete with their personalized music taste. The only way to be a "Good DJ," in 2015 is by being interesting, fun and slightly unpredictable. That being said, I never consider myself to be "Good," so much as I see myself being honest. We're in the entertainment business, and "Good," is a matter of opinion.

Q: What's your most memorable on-air faux pas?

A: Oh man. There's been a few. The most recent one would probably be when I tried to explain to a guest how to use the bidet at Family Mart. It raised a few eyebrows that's for sure, but I didn't see it as a problem. The real reason for even bringing up a bidet on AFN Radio is because I firmly believe in trying new things. Japan is a wonderful country, innovative and often times more convenient than what many service members are used to in the United States. If we hold on too hard to what we expect from our own country we will never fully appreciate how wonderful others are.

Q: Any message for your fans?

A: It's been four years I've been on-air here in Okinawa, and it's been a wonderful experience. I've loved coming to work every day and sharing my life with you. I will miss Japan and it will always hold a special place in my heart. I never come to work expecting awards like this, and I'm very humbled to be chosen for the second straight year. My biggest message in parting would be to get out of your comfort zone. Travel, be a part of a different culture.

I believe Mark Twain said it best: "Travel is fatal to prejudice, bigotry, and narrow-mindedness. Many of our people need it sorely on these accounts. Broad, wholesome, charitable views of men and things cannot be acquired by vegetating in one little corner of the earth all one's lifetime."

Best of Pacific voters in the Republic of Korea come off as pragmatic in this year’s balloting. Sure, they enjoy good times, good deals and a great host country as much as anyone else. But reoccurring references to “reliable,” “customer service,” “selection” and “price” hint that businesses and organizations elected best here are first and foremost tried and true.

We don’t know if this trend has anything to do with the fact most of the 28,500 U.S. troops officially estimated by U.S. Forces Korea to be in the ROK are Army. However, we can say that compared to recent years, representation for that branch of service in this year’s voting was, well - Army strong!

Past trends were also bucked in that Yongsan Garrison did not dominate the polls this year. And Kunsan Air Base voter

Where else,” he asks, “can anyone do that?” While Osan’s Emmanuel Jones insists you can’t beat “all the unique shops and variety of shopping” right outside the gate. For Gayle Clark on Camp Casey, all the “interesting choices and friendly staff in a small trendy environment,” are what make the Frying Pan Blue’s Sunday brunch the best in Itaewon.

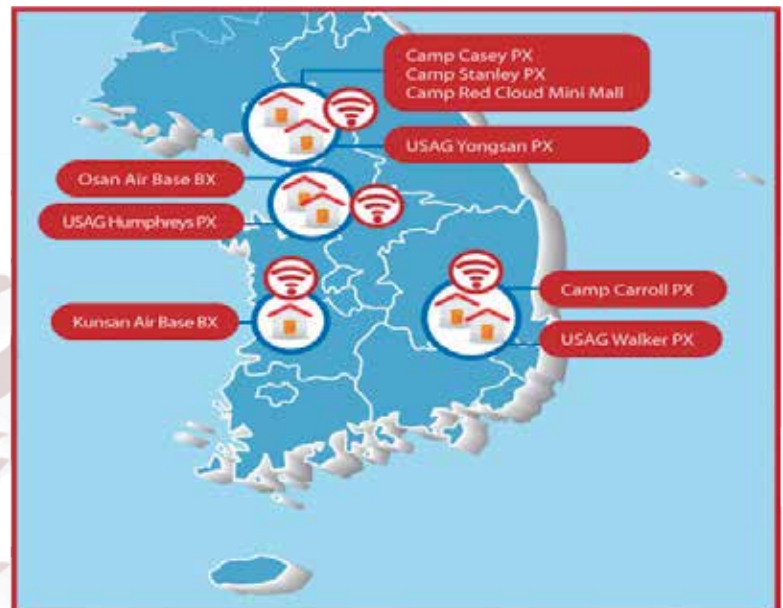

A: I love the interaction with the audience. We made sure we had guests from every group/unit on base come on and tell the latest information.

Q: What's the key to being a good DJ?

A: Know your audience. I think of them sitting at their desk or hanging out at



home and talk to them like they are my good friend. I get to play music to make them feel good and tell them what they don't want to miss that week.

Q: What's your most memorable on-air faux pas?

A: Anything can happen in live radio which makes it so exciting. I think my listeners were waiting to see if I would do something goofy next. I would fire a song and promptly turn it off. Not sure why. Left my microphone on a few times. Luckily, I didn't say anything too ridiculous.

Q: Any message for your fans?

A: Thank you for listening. I was in Korea two years and on the radio most of that time. I didn't waste any time, getting as many people to come on my show and share their information. That's what was important to me.

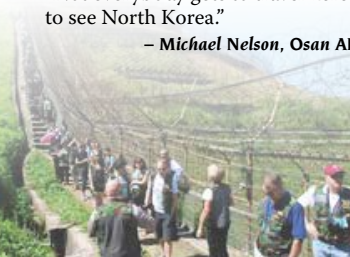

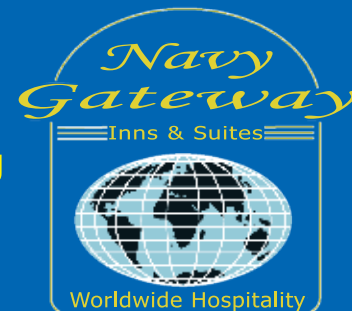
