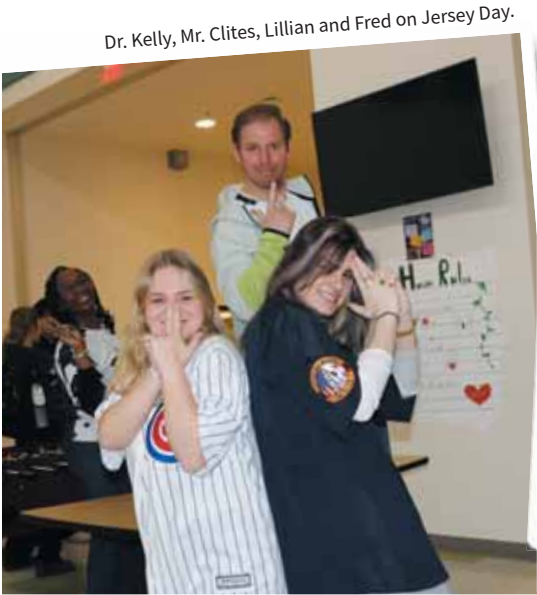

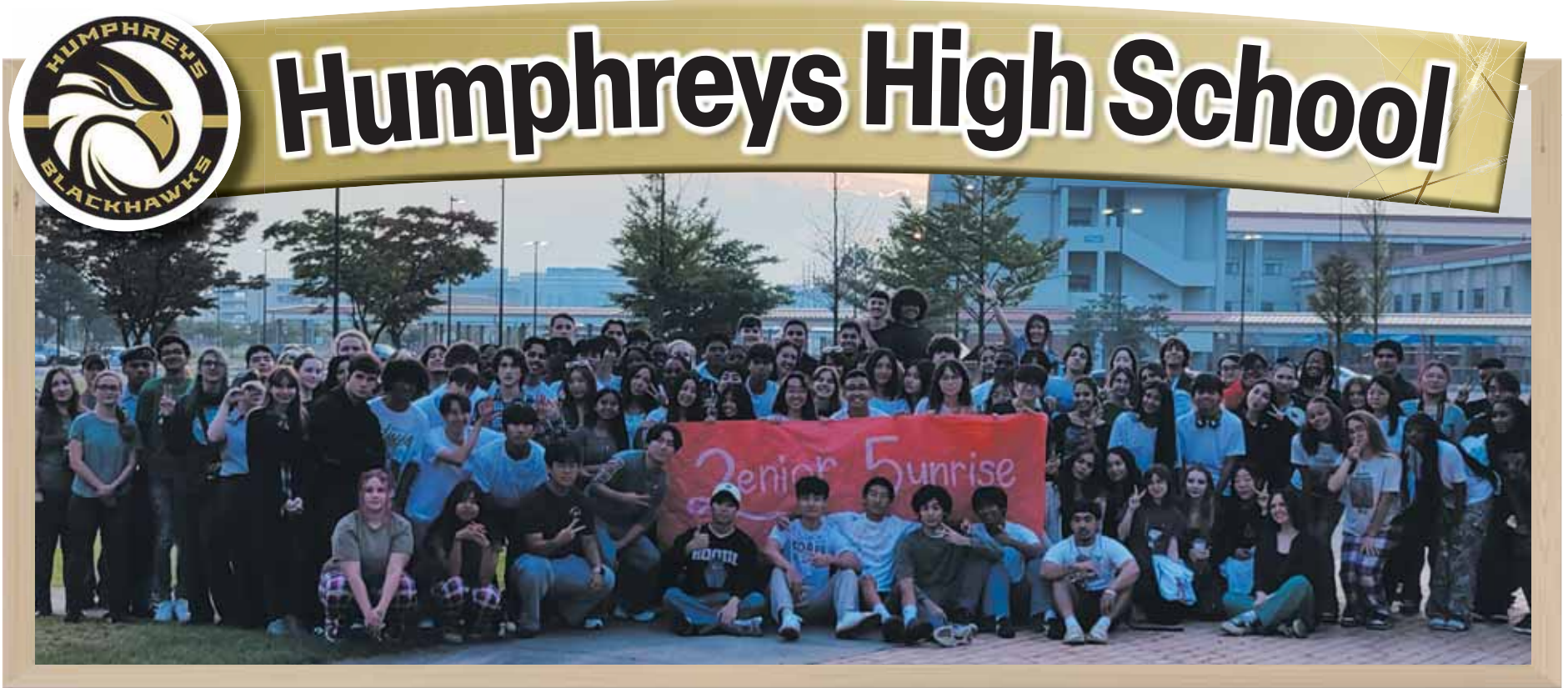

We thank our sponsors, from the service members to the DOD employees, for everything they’ve done for us. They ultimately were the ones who brought us into this community, and this experience.

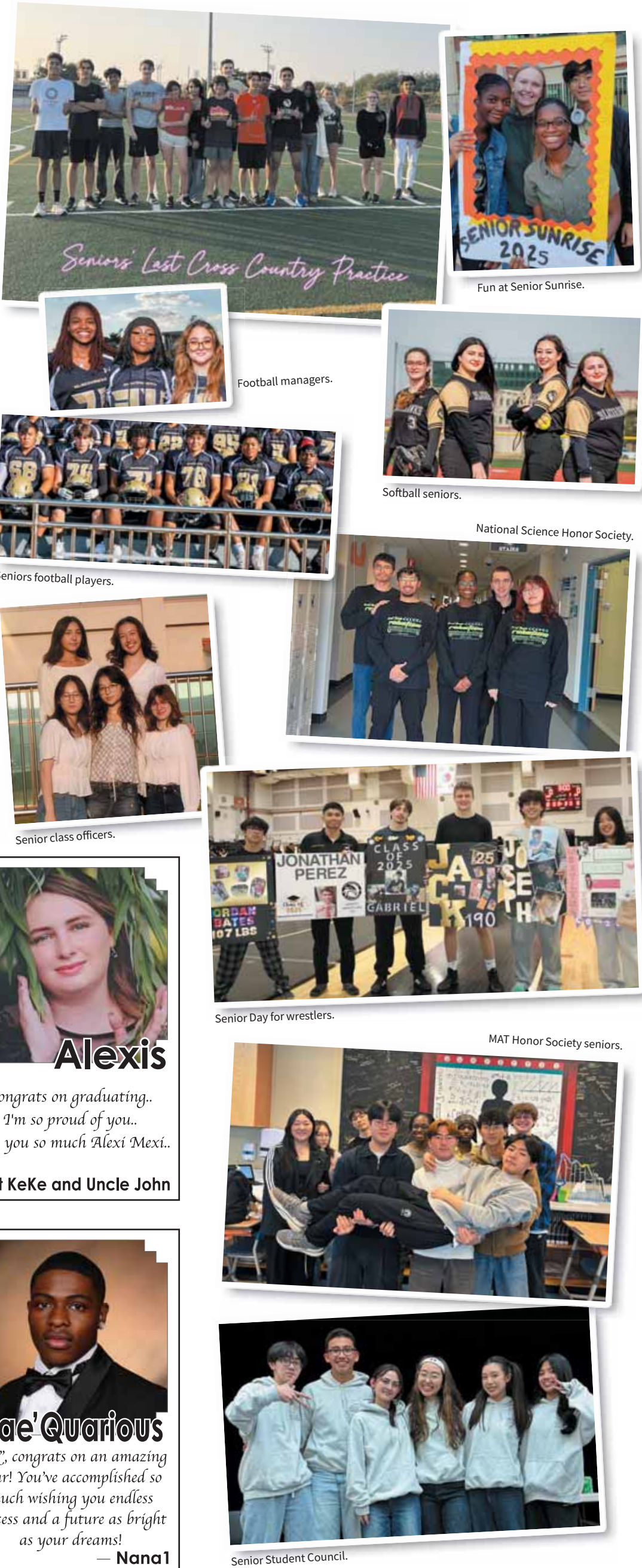
We appreciate the support that the Humphreys community has provided through numerous opportunities, both educational, personal, and social.

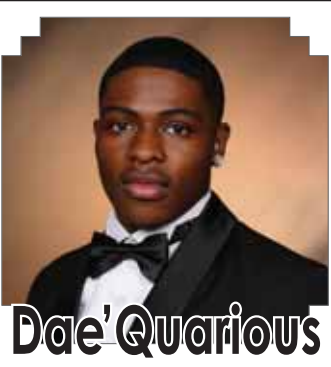




