Know rules of road for PTDs in Korea

s you begin to venture out beyond the gates of your installation, you may notice there are many electric scooters out and about. These are a great way to explore the neighborhood and surrounding areas without having to catch a bus or a train. These powered vehicles, known as Personal Transportation Devices (PTD), range from electric scooters and electric skateboards to Segways (kickboards in Korea), mopeds and hoverboards. Before you look into hopping on these PTDs, make sure you know the rules of the road!

U.S. Forces Korea released guidelines for the use of PTDs

that applies to active duty and civilian personnel. First, you will need to register your PTD within 10 days of purchase, lease or rent at your base Pass and ID Office. PTD riders will also be required to wear a helmet, closed-toe shoes and a reflective vest or belt. Your PTD should have operating lights when riding during the evening hours or in times of limited visibility. Also, it's important to know that PTDs follow the same traffic rules on the road as motor vehicles.

Violation of any of these rules could mean a ticket and a ban from using the PTD until the correct equipment is secured. Take note that repeat offenders could also lead to military sponsorship problems.

So, if you're interested in hitching a ride on a shiny new PTD, make sure you know the rules of the road. Safe riding!



inju City has evolved into a captivating "residence-type tourist city," enticing visitors to explore and extend their stays.

Notable attractions such as the Jinju Namgang Yudeung Exhibition Hall, Kim Si-min Ho, Mulbitnaru Rest Area, and the Jinju K-Entrepreneurship Center, along with accommodations like Jisoo Seungsan Hanok, are gaining widespread popularity.

In the past year, concerted efforts were made to enhance tourism infrastructure and transform Jinju into a destination that attracts and accommodates visitors.

New attractions, including the Jinju Namgang Yudeung Exhibition Hall, the Namgang Cruise Ship 'Kim Si-minho,' and the Jinju K-Entrepreneurship Center, were introduced to showcase the unique charm of Jinju Bay.

Here are six experiences to put on your to-do list if you're planning to visit the Jinju area.

1 Jinju Namgang Yudeung Exhibition Hall

The exhibition hall, opened in October 2023, focuses on lanterns and symbolizes Jinju. With over 43,000 visitors since its launch, it features year-round displays of Yudeung, contributing to the 'Wonderful Namgang Project.'

The space, covering 2761m2, includes an exhibition area, experience space, office space, a cafe, and a rooftop garden.

The inaugural exhibition, themed 'The Light of Yudeung, Filled with Hope,' showcased winners of the Korea Lantern Contest, silk hope lantern tunnels, and multimedia content exploring the origins of Yudeung and Jinju's identity. Collaborations with artists added a modern interpretation,

making it an engaging experience for visitors.

2 Kim Si-min-ho and Mulbitnaru Rest Area

The Namgang cruise ship 'Kim Si-min-ho' saw over 19,000 passengers last year, offering a serene journey along the Namgang River with breathtaking views of Jinju Castle and the cityscape.

The ticket booth, 'Mulbitnaru Rest Area,' recognized for its architectural excellence, is a must-visit destination.

The eco-friendly Kim Si-min No. 2 is set to start operations from September, expanding opportunities for more visitors to enjoy the beauty of Jinju.

3 Jinju K-Entrepreneurship Center

Remodeled from the old Jisu Elementary School, the center, inaugurated in March 2022, provides entrepreneurship education. Over 4,700 CEOs and 2,000 stu-

dents have undergone Jinju K-Entrepreneurship training.

With over 80,000 visitors, it has become a prominent hub for entrepreneurship education. The global expansion project, highlighted by Mayor Cho Gyu-il's UN Small and Medium

Business Day keynote speech and international forums, has garnered significant attention.

4 Seungsan-e Rich Hanok and Jisoo Nammyeong Jinchwiga

Opened in June 2022, Seungsan-e Rich Hanok and Jisoo Nammyeong Jinchwiga offer unique lodging experiences, attracting around 4,700 guests.

Seungsan Ebuja Hanok provides a blend of past and present in the tranquil Seungsan Village, while Jisoo

Nammyeong Jinchwiga, a wooden building, received accolades for its modern reinterpretation of Hanok.

5 Folk Beef Strength Competition and Saturday Permanent Games

The city hosts the 'National Folk Beef Strength Competition' and Saturday games to promote traditional folk culture and support livestock farmers.


In 2023, 25 regular games drew about 10,000 spectators, and the national competition during the Jinju Namgang Yudeung Festival attracted over 22,000 visitors.

Regular Saturday games will continue this year, offering unique attractions for tourists.

6 Jinju Woodcraft Training Center

The city aims to popularize woodcraft through the 'Jinju Woodcraft Training Center,' with more than 40,000 participants since 2018.

In 2023, approximately 9,800 people engaged in various programs, signaling a 25% increase. The center offers diverse woodworking experiences and education programs, including calligraphy, woven furniture, and DIY, operating on weekdays and weekends.

ilgokgun is full of wonderful walks and these ones will take you to this Korean region's many reservoirs. Trails vary from easy to moderate, and in a couple of cases, can be slightly strenuous.

Looking for a change of pace? There are some great walks to take around Chilgokgun which will allow you to reconnect with nature and get some fresh air. Below are five spots for a nice mix of beautiful countryside and picture-perfect waters.

1 Nakdonggang Riverside Walk

This walking track makes for an easy stroll along the Nakdonggang River with scenic views, historic spots and great wildlife-watching opportunities.

The walk loops around the expansive river, so you can choose whatever starting point is convenient for you. If you are coming from Camp Carroll, make the bridge over the river your start and end point. If you have a car, you can start your family-friendly jaunt at Chilgokbo Weir. The building serves as one of the certification centers where cyclists get their stamps to certify completion of the River Bike Path

From there, you can also set off on a bike ride as the park also has a fantastic bicycle path that leads to Busan where Nakdonggang River ends.

Along the route near the dam, look down for the rare fish ladder structures. These are artificial steps built to facilitate natural migration of fish. If you're lucky, you can spot a school of fish moving through the fishway on the side of the weir.

The weir generates electricity for the region, so you'll be able to see the roaring waters as you cross the weir bridge. Once you've crossed, the trail will lead you past a pavilion to the Gwanho Fortress, which is over 1,500 years old. Go up the hill, then you can get a bird's eye view of the river and its beautiful surroundings.

Down the hill, you'll reach a camping site on the river's edge, which is also accessible from the bridge. The campsite is an easy place for family-friendly fun and a great spot for

a casual BBQ.

Past the campsite, there is a 265-meter-long bridge that takes you to the largest outdoor pool in the Gyeongsangdo area. At night, the bridge is lit up with LED lights, creating a beautiful sight.

Camp Carroll

If you want to see a different side of the river, make a beeline for Waegwan Railroad Bridge from the bicycle tour certification center. The short 1.3-kilometer-long walking path will have you walking across different landscapes including sand, grass, wooded and paved roads. During the hot summer season, don't miss the musical fountain with water perfectly synchronized to popular K-Pop songs.

For a touch of history, stop at the Waegwan Railroad Bridge near the end of the second walking course. During the Korean War, this bridge played an important role in slowing North Korean soldiers who were advancing south. The 1st U.S. Cavalry Division, blasted off one-floor section of the bridge, which made it difficult to cross. There are still remnants of this damage on the steel structure, a reminder of the devastation caused by the war.

From there, cross the bridge and walk in a counterclock-wise direction if you want to explore more of the area. On this walk you'll enjoy stunning views of flora and fauna and plenty of spots to catch your breath and take it all in.

For a road less traveled, head to Waegwan's Jicheonji (지천지), a 3.5-kilometer-long loop walk with a couple of steep hills and stairs. Though part of this walk may be difficult for small children and elderly people, half of the walk features a flat, paved path ideal for walkers of all ages and fitness levels. It's only a 10-minute drive from Camp Carroll.

This is a perfect place for all kinds of recreation, including water skiing, camping and much more. Nature lovers will enjoy the ducks and birds that call this place home. Go up to Nakwahdam Observatory at the top of the hill for a stunning view of the reservoir.

3 Yuhakji Reservoir Circular

Yuhakji (유학자) is a serene 1.7-kilometer-long trek and a perfect pondside stroll. The walk also features a tiny, wobbly suspension bridge, forested roads, and the refreshing scent of the water nearby. You can reach this walk via a 20-minute drive from Camp Carroll.

For a look at the entire pond and a shaded place for wildlife observation, stop at the pavilion in the parking lot. The pavilion and trail are popular among local residents, but you can still enjoy some solitude during quieter times of the day. There are also coffees shops near the pond to get your caffeine fix and take a rest for a while. Your furry friends are welcome but must be on a leash.



Dumanji Reservoir Walk

Dumanji Reservoir (두만지) is a well-maintained path in Yangmok and is only a 15-minute drive from Camp Carroll. Drive past secluded villages and Yangmok traditional market, and then you'll reach the reservoir. Park your car at the shrine adjacent to the walk-

ing path.



If you're interested in history, stop at the shrine where General Sin Yu's tablet is enshrined. General Sin Yu is known for his defeat of the Russian Army around the Amur River in the Joseon Dynasty (1392-1897).

From the shrine, take a leisurely stroll along a wooden walkway. This little-known

spot is also a place for cherry blossom-viewing in the spring season. The 150-meter-long cherry blossom promenade might be too short but worth a visit.

Take the path through the forest for more incredible views and soon you'll reach a high spot for a look from above at the reservoir.

Dongmyeongji Reservoir (동명지) is a picturesque spot about a half-hour drive away from Camp keep an eye out for native birds like mallards that

Walker and Camp Carroll. With its wide-open spaces, dazzling waterfront views, and beautiful parks, the path offers the perfect setting for a lovely escapade or quality family time. The reservoir paths feature floating walkways that allow you to walk on the water so you can feel close to nature.

This beautiful spot is also part of the Pilgrim's Way that starts from Gasil Catholic Church and ends

at the historical Hanti Martyrs' Site where martyrs were killed and buried in the mid-1800s. The pilgrim route was recently created as a 40-kilometerlong trekking course consisting of five themed sections inspired by the path that Catholics used to walk to the Hanti Martyrs' Site in the early 19th Century to escape persecution.

While you're making your way through this trail,

populate the reservoir. When night comes, you'll have an opportunity to take in the beauty of the suspension bridge illuminated with vibrant colors.


Make a quick stop at Songnimsa Temple(송림 사), known for its fivestory brick pagoda that dates back to the ninth century, on your way back home. If you have no idea what to eat in the area, head to Dong-

gungjeong(동궁정), a Korean restaurant that serves up tasty rice with seasoned vegetables and cheonggukjang (fast-fermented bean paste).

Market (노량진 수산시장) is a great spot to

foreigners for many reasons. Without a doubt, the Noryangjin Fish Market is one of the best places to find incredibly fresh seafood in the center of Seoul. Also, before having a seafood feast, seeing a variety of sea creatures swimming in water tanks is a very unique experience. You might think some of the creatures are strange as you see them for the first time in your life. I promise that although they might jump out to try a jail breakout, they won't attack you like the Kraken!

Some of my American friends are not the type to usually order seafood. They say it's because a lot of the U.S. is not near the ocean, so they are normally used to other meats. But when I have been able to introduce Korean seafood dishes into their life, they have always found at least one entree they enjoyed. I cannot stress enough how many different seafood options there are in a Korean fish market.

Because many Americans don't eat as much seafood as Koreans, many might avoid walking through a fish market. Some of them might even think the smell is unbearable. However, because a lot of the fish are still alive, the smell is tolerable. Fish can be your friends or food!

When visiting the market, you'll feel like you are in a special aquarium where you can select the displays as your dinner.

Location: Seoul Metro Line 1,9 Noryangjin station exit 9

- Markets: runs 24 hours, but many closed by 10 p.m.
- Restaurants: 10 a.m.-10 p.m. (Mostly)

1st&2nd floors: Fresh things from the sea 2 nd floors: Dried and salted seafood 2 nd &5th floors: Restaurants 3rd &4th floors: Parking lots



2. Check the market price first

Explore the first and second floors before purchasing any items. To check the standard price of an item, visit two or three different shops and ask the price of the item. Vendors are used to it, so don't be afraid of asking the price even if you aren't going to buy from them.

Also, most vendors follow standardized prices fixed by the market, and the quality of the service provided by a vendor can be very different depending on the shop.

3. Decide where to eat

You can either take the items to your home or have them cooked at restaurants in the market. Eating at the restaurant is a very convenient way to enjoy the amazing seafood you purchased. The vendor you bought your seafood from will guide you to a restaurant that will cook your food.

However, the restaurants charge service fees for offering table setting, side dishes, and cooking the items, which can often be even more expensive than the seafood itself. So the most cost-effective option is to take the ingredients home with you.

4. Ask for discounts (haggle)

Don't hesitate to haggle or ask for extra stuff, especially when you are buying expensive items. Just by asking, the vendor might lower the price or add extra products such as clams or shrimp for free!

5. Culturally changing

Many foreigners experience uncomfortable situations by vendors when shopping at traditional markets. It's true that Noryangjin Fish Market used to have a bad reputation of selling items with expensive prices and overcharging tourists. However, nowadays these actions are prohibited and the market has put a lot of effort in changing the culture and environment in a positive way.

Customers should report to the customer service center on the second floor if they experience any of the following acts from a vendor:

- Forcefully asking customers to come to their shop
- Swapping purchased items
- Misrepresenting the country of origin
- Cheating on the weight (By adding water in the basket, using their hand to put pressure on the scale, scale not zeroed correctly, not deducting the weight of the basket,

The first 30 minutes are free then a 1,000 won charge is added every 20 minutes. Ask vendors for a parking voucher after you purchase items from them. Each ticket will provide a 1,000 won discount.

Make sure to pay the fee through the machine by the customer service center on the second floor or next to the elevators on the third and fourth floors.

Guide to family-friendly trip in Starfield Anseong




