SERVICES INITALY

These are some key services that are helpful to set up after you have arrived.

BANKING

Getting an Italian account with an International Bank Account Number (IBAN) is necessary for paying bills and transferring money. It is also helpful for making purchases, getting cash and managing funds between dollars and euros.

USING DEBIT CARDS IN EUROPE

- Chip and Pin cards are the norm throughout Europe.
- Smaller Italian businesses may not take credit cards.
- · Always carry euros when off-installation.
- Some U.S. banks charge international transaction fees when using debit cards, so check with your bank.

ON-INSTALLATION BANKING OPTIONS

- ► Global Credit Union is one of the largest credit unions in the U.S. and offers members competitive rates and surchargefree ATMs.

- Community Bank provides convenient and affordable banking services and financial information to help support service members, base organizations and mission readiness.
 - Located at: Aviano, Camp Darby, Caserme Ederle, Caserme Del Din.
 - Call toll-free: 00-800-BANK-EASY (00-800-2265-3279) from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on holidays.

PAYING BILLS

Italian bill paying is different than in the U.S. There are three methods you can use.

▶ Pay In Cash

- Bring your bill and cash payment to a tobacco store (Tabaccheria) or bank teller. Expect a small fee.
- Bring your bill to a local bank to set up automatic transfers and automatic direct debits, you will usually need a funds transfer form.
- ► Online bank transfer via your local Italian bank or online bank such as WISE.
 - Set up a payee account with an IBAN number.
 - Verify the euro amount and date for payment.
 - Include your account number (codice cliente) and bill number (numero Fattura).
- ▶ Online via the billing company's website.
 - This can be done with an Italian-issued credit card.

BEWARE OF FEES

- Off-installation ATMs (bancomat) may have transaction fees, but usually have better exchange rates.
- Check conversion rates before transferring large amounts between U.S. and euro accounts.
- The DoD will not deposit paychecks into Italian banks.


LEGAL SERVICES

Your on-installation Legal Office can help with simple notaries and powers of attorney on a walk-in basis. Complex notary services and other legal advice is available by appointment.

- ➤ Powers of Attorney are recommended for spouses so they may handle paperwork if the military sponsor is not available due to training or deployment.
- ► Dependents wanting to work while overseas should discuss SOFA regulations with the legal office.
- ► A tax center is available during the tax season.
- ▶ Other legal services offered include wills, medical directives, Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA) issues, estate planning, immigration, debt or credit problems, identity theft, divorce counseling and Italian legal issues. ■







Upon arrival, setting up your cell phone is vital. There are a variety of options in Italy and plans tend to be very affordable.

CELL PHONES

Providers: Vodafone, TIM, WINDTRE, Iliad

Service contracts

- · Approximately two to three years.
- Breaking contracts is not an option.
- · No military clause included.

Pay as you go option (Ricaricabile)

- · Expect a startup fee.
- · Renews every four weeks (not monthly).
- Set up an online account to view or change your plan.
- Deactivating voicemail and SMS missed call notices is recommended to avoid extra charges.

What to bring to set up a cellphone plan (on-installation):

✓ ID

✓ Address

✓ Codice Fiscale (for contract plans)

Apps to communicate internationally for free via Wi-Fi:

Note: When you arrive, put your phone in airplane mode to avoid unexpected charges.







TRANSPORTATION IN ITALY >>>

DRIVER'S LICENSES

USAG Italy requires a SETAF license for all drivers.

- The Southern European Task Force (SETAF) license is only valid in NATO countries, though not all recognize it. An International Driving Permit (IDP) or Italian driver's license is recommended for trips outside of Italy.
- Drivers must be 18 years old or older.

You have the option to take the SETAF course and exam in person or online.

- ▶ In person: Take the driver's orientation class at the Central Processing facility, take the SETAF license test and submit documentation at the Driver's Testing Office.
- ▶ Online: Register at jko.jten.mil, take the USA-007 U.S. Forces Driver's Training Program for Europe course and pass exam, print both pre-course and final exam certificates and submit with documentation at the Driver's Testing Office.

Required documents:

- ✓ AEF 1901T
- Current U.S. driver's license
- ✓ Military ID
- ✓ Copy of Orders
- ✓ JKO certificates (if taken online)

AVIANO AIR BASE

- Requires an AFI license for all drivers.
- The Allied Forces in Italy (AFI) license is only valid in Italy. Obtain an International Driving Permit (IDP) for trips outside of Italy.
- The active-duty sponsor must be issued their AFI license before dependents may apply.
- All drivers must be 18 years old or older.
- Download study material from 31fss.com/driving-overseas

- Complete the online test. It has 100 questions, and you may only miss 10 to pass.
- · Submit application online.

INTERNATIONAL DRIVING PERMIT (IDP)

To drive outside of Italy, it is recommended that you obtain a yearly IDP from aaa.com/vacation/idpf.html for \$20.

ITALIAN DRIVER'S LICENSE

It is possible to get an Italian driver's license which is valid for five to ten years, depending on your age. This license will allow you to drive in any European country. These cost roughly 270 euros and requires an application, a SETAF/AFI license, a Codice Fiscale and copy of your passport. Visit the Driver's Testing Office for applications and details.

MOTORCYCLES

If you want to ride a motorcycle while in Italy, you must have a motorcycle classification on your U.S. license, have an AFI/SETAF license, attend a motorcycle safety course or have an approved rider course card. Motorcyclists can only operate a motorcycle of 35 kW or less.

WINTER DRIVING

From Nov. 15 to Apr. 15, you must have winter tires (M+S/All Weather) installed or have snow chains in your vehicle. Road conditions and requirements vary throughout Italy. Contact your base Safety Office for specific rules.

REGISTERING A VEHICLE

At Aviano, vehicles must be registered at the 31st Security Forces Squadron AMVRO before the vehicle can be picked up from the Vehicle Processing Center (VPC).

AVIANO AIR BASE

- ➤ Steps for registering and picking up your vehicle:
- 1. Receive the vehicle arrival email from VPC. Complete the attached 302 customs form. Receive an email with a cover plate assignment.

- 2. Set up insurance.
- Complete registration online or make reservation to complete it in person. Required paperwork:
 - a. PCS orders / Logistical Support Letter (DOD civilians) / DOCPERS (contractors)
 - b. CAC or Dependent ID
 - c. U.S. driver's license
 - d. AFI driver's license
 - e. Five euros in cash
 - **f.** Proof of insurance (with VIN, policy number and dates)
- **4.** Receive a registration completion email. Pick up vehicle registration and plates.
- 5. Go to the VPC to install plates and pick up the vehicle. Bring safety equipment to place in the car (orange vest, triangle and first aid kit).
- 6. Safety inspection at VPC.
- **7.** Submit safety inspection at the registration office and receive fuel card authorization to take to AAFES for Fuel Card (primary vehicle only).

USAG ITALY - VICENZA,

Vehicles are registered and picked up at the VPC in Torri di Quartesolo. A shuttle bus is available to the VPC.

- ► At USAG Italy Camp Darby, the vehicle registration office in building 113. Vehicles are picked up at the Livorno VPC.
- ► USAG Italy steps for registering and picking up your vehicle:
- 1. Receive the arrival email from VPC.
- **2.** Register the vehicle with the following paperwork:
 - a. Military ID
 - **b.** SETAF driver's license
 - c. U.S. driver's license
 - d. Proof of ownership (title)
 - e. Shipping document
 - f. PCS orders, DOCPERS (contractors), Logistical support letter (DOD civilians)
 - g. Cash for registration fees
 - h. Power of Attorney, if needed
- 3. Get a license plate number.
- 4. Set up and print proof of insurance.



- 5. Pick up registration and plates at the office. Bring proof of insurance and all other documentation.
- 6. Vehicle inspection at the VPC.
- 7. Install license plate (best to bring tools to the VPC).
- 8. Vehicle safety inspection. Bring all paperwork and required vehicle safety items: orange vest, warning triangle and first aid kit.
- 9. Submit inspection form to registration office and get fuel coupon to take to AAFES for Fuel Card (one vehicle only).

VEHICLE INSPECTION

All vehicles assigned to USAG Italy are required to be inspected and registered annually.

Vehicles assigned to Aviano require an annual inspection if the manufacture date is less than five years old.

▶ Things to double-check before an inspection:

- Vehicle registration is valid
- Safety equipment is in the vehicle: First-aid kit, warning triangle and reflective vest
- · Light are all in working order
- Tires are not excessively worn. During winter, all-season or M+S tires must be used
- Brake pads are not worn
- Windshield is not cracked
- Vehicle body is not missing parts

BUYING A CAR IN ITALY

You have the option to buy a new or used car from dealers and private sellers in Italy. There is no tax when buying a vehicle from another military member.

► Keep in mind:

- Any vehicle that doesn't have U.S. specifications (specs) cannot be shipped to the U.S.
- Used automatic transmission vehicles may be difficult
- Get approval through a bona fide financial institution if financing a vehicle.

Driving

- Driving is fast paced in Italy and Italian drivers may come across as impatient.
- Italians do not consider it rude to tailgate.
- Horns are used excessively, so it is difficult to deter mine who they are intended for. Try to notice what is happening and ignore the extra beeping.
- Hazard lights are used to indicate that traffic is slow and attention is needed.

FUELING A VEHICLE

NATO Forces fuel cards are only available to be used with one primary vehicle. The cards exclude Italian taxes, which saves roughly 40 percent of fuel costs.

► NATO Forces Fuel Card

- Allows you to pay for fuel at the current tax-free price.
- · The vehicle's engine size, engine base, horsepower and fuel equipment determine the ration amount.
- After registration you will receive a fuel card approval. Take this to your local AAFES to get your Fuel Card.
- The card is accepted only at ENI and AGIP stations.
- To use the card, swipe or insert the card and enter your secure PIN.
- Fuel transactions are billed to the payment method provided during registration.
- · You will receive a bi-weekly invoice as well as a monthly statement.

▶ Where to get gas

- · There are no gas stations on any U.S. military installation
- Only two Italian gas stations will take your NATO Fuel Card: AGIP and ENI.

▶ To pump fuel

- "Benzina" Unleaded gas
- · "Gasolio" Diesel
- "Fai dat Te" Self-service station
- "Servito" Full-service station
- Blue pump Diesel+
- Green pump Super unleaded gas (95 Octane)
- Yellow pump Super-S (98) or Super+ (100) ■

HOUSING

There is plenty of variety when it comes to housing in Italy. Whether you end up living on-installation or find a house locally, it will be exciting to settle into your new home.

ON-INSTALLATION HOUSING

AVIANO

- There is no government housing for accompanied personnel on base at Aviano.
- You will receive an extensive Housing Brochure at the Wyvern Welcome that outlines the steps that must be taken to secure a rental home. Spouses are welcome to the briefing.
- The Housing Management Office is located in Area F (Flightline) in Bldg 1409.
- Unaccompanied airmen E-1 to E-3, and E-4 with less than three years of service will be assigned to an on-base dormitory at the UH Campus near the flight line in area F.
- Key and essential personnel have access to governmentally-leased housing that is within 15 minutes of the base.

CAMP DARBY

- You will meet with Housing representatives during mandatory In-Processing.
- The Housing Services Office is located in Bldg 413.
- Barracks are available for single soldiers.
- There is no family housing on Camp Darby; however, government-leased homes will be offered.
- If no government-leased housing is vacant, you must secure a private housing rental. Lists of approved homes are available at the Housing office.

VICENZA

You will receive a Housing Day 1
 Briefing. Spouses are welcome to attend. Additionally, soldiers meet with a Housing representative at the Central Processing Facility (CPF), Bldg 393 to determine eligibility.

- The Housing Office is located off-post 100 meters outside the "Housing Gate" (Gate 4).
- Government family housing is avail able on-post in the Villaggio Della Pace community. The community includes the DoDEA schools, child development center, youth centers and a shoppette.
- Government-leased housing is also available in the surrounding communities. If you are offered a government-leased home, your TLA with discontinue whether you accept or decline the unit.
- If government housing is not available, you will need to seek private housing.

GOVERNMENT-LEASED HOUSING

Government-leased homes are typically entire apartment buildings or multi-home units leased by the U.S. government. The housing office is responsible for assigning homes to incoming families. The government pays for rent, utilities and maintenance, much like traditional on-post housing. You will not receive an Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA) if you are assigned government-leased housing.

PRIVATE HOUSING RENTALS

Private homes in the local community are available to rent. They must be assessed and approved for use by your installation's Housing Office before you sign a lease. If you lease a private house, you will be responsible for paying rent and utilities, and are expected to provide basic maintenance. You will receive an Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA) to defray these housing costs.



Local provincial fiscal authorities determine who is exempt from paying the Italian national Value Added Tax (VAT) on purchases. For this reason, different locations have varying policies.

AVIANO: Military members stationed at Aviano are exempt from paying tax on vehicle repairs. Visit the base Legal Office with your registration to receive a notarized VAT form. This can then be used to eliminate taxes when paying for repairs.

WICENZA / CAMP DARBY: Military members stationed at USAG Italy are exempt from paying the Imposta sul Valore Aggiunto (IVA), otherwise known as VAT, on household goods and car parts from specific businesses in the region. The exemption only applies to purchases over 150 euros at a single business. Visit the Tax Relief Office (TRO) for detailed instructions.

HOUSE HUNTING OFF-INSTALLATION

Many newcomers to Northern Italy find private housing in the local community.

FINDING A HOME

- Search for available and approved rentals at homes.mil
- Houses come and go quickly, so check the site daily.
- You may choose to use a realtor: however, you are responsible for realtor fees (usually one month's rent and 22 percent tax), and the Housing Office will need to approve your final choice.

VIEWING A HOME

AVIANO:

Arrange to view a home by using the contact information in the house listing on homes. mil. If you do not have a vehicle, your sponsor should assist in transporting you to house viewings. All units must be inspected by a housing specialist before the approved Rental Agreement can be signed. Expect to pay a deposit to hold the home.

VICENZA / CAMP DARBY:

Request to view a home in-person at the Housing office. This request holds the home for you until you can view it. You may have two homes on hold at one time. Housing will schedule a time for a taxi and interpreter to take you to view the home; this service can only be used to view five homes. You have 24 hours after viewing a home to notify the Housing Office of your intent to rent. Lease signing will be scheduled at the Housing Office with a lease counselor and the landlord, you will then be driven back to the house to note any problems and receive the keys. You must pay a deposit before moving in and submit a copy of the payment to the Housing Office.

OVERSEAS HOUSING ALLOWANCE

Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA) covers:

- Rent You will be paid the exact amount of your rental agreement up to the maximum allowance based on your grade. Renting at a higher amount will result in out-of-pocket expenses and requires command approval at USAG Italy.
- Utilities You will receive a monthly utility allowance.

Move-In Housing Allowance (MIHA)

- MIHA Miscellaneous is a one-time lump sum payment for costs incurred during your move. This is designed to help you pay for items like transformers, utility installation fees, window screens, ward robes, etc.
- MIHA Painting / Redecorating Fee is a reimbursement your landlord may ask you to file so they may receive a refund for painting the interior of the home. This will be approved ahead of time during the lease signing.
- MIHA Security allowance may be available
 if your home is not already equipped
 with basic security features like a front
 door viewer, dead bolts, basement
 window grates and exterior lighting.

LOANER FURNISHINGS

AVIANO: Temporary loaner furniture is available from the Furnishing Management Section (FMS) so you will have basic items like beds, dressers, a table and a couch while you wait for your household goods shipment. In addition, appliances are available to borrow for the duration of your tour. These consist of a washer, dryer, refrigerator and stove.

VICENZA / CAMP DARBY: At your lease signing, you will choose what temporary furniture you would like delivered to your new home. This includes basic items like beds, dressers, tables and couches, plus appliances like a washer, dryer, stove and refrigerator. You will need to call the Furniture Warehouse to have temporary furnishings removed from your home. This may be done twice, typically before your household goods arrival and before you move out.

UTILITIES

Installation and setup fees can be high. Italian bills are sent every two months and are usually due within one week. Keep a record of all rental and utility payments in case they get lost or misrouted.

ELECTRICITY AND HEATING

AVIANO: Visit the Home Fuel Office to set up natural gas and electricity rental agreements. This tax exemption program can greatly reduce your utility costs.

Homes heated with Gasolio (diesel fuel or oil) may also be able to use the program if they do not share a heating system with adjacent apartments or units.

VICENZA / CAMP DARBY: At your lease signing an appointment will be made for an interpreter to accompany you in person to the electric company. Be prepared to pay a fee and deposit. Roughly 10 days later, your initial bill and contract will arrival in the mail. These must be taken to the Housing Office so they can submit the contract on your behalf.

You are responsible for establishing and paying your heating bill. This is usually natural gas or oil. Visit your Tax Relief Office to sign up for the Utility Tax Exemption Program (UTEP) to avoid paying taxes on heating fuel.

WATER

Water bills are typically paid directly to your landlord and may only come every two, three or six months.

INTERNET SERVICE

Your landlord is your best resource for finding good internet service at your new home.

- Commonly used providers: TKS, Tim, Wind, Vodafone, FastWeb, Trivenet, Infostrada, Telemar, Open Skies
- Be prepared to wait.
- Installation appointments are often scheduled two to four weeks out and are commonly cancelled and rescheduled.
- Even after it is installed, services may take up to a week to begin working.

TELEVISION SERVICE

AFN (American Forces Network)

- Provides programming from current American networks and prime channels.
- Satellite TV requirements:
- A satellite dish that carries AFN programming installed at your home.
- A decoder box with transformer. These are available as temporary furnishings.
- The AFN Now App can be used on Android and iOS platforms in addition to some streaming devices like a Fire Stick or smart TV.
- Visit afn-now.myafn.mil for details and registration.

STREAMING SERVICES

- Examples Amazon Prime, Netflix, Hulu, Sky, Pluto, Peacock.
- Show variety and availability will reflect your new location in Italy. Using a Virtual Private Network (VPN) may allow you to access U.S. versions.

HEALTHCARE IN ITALY

MEDICAL CARE OPTIONS

► AVIANO

The 31st Medical Group offers primary care for active-duty service members and their dependents while stationed at Aviano Air Base. All other patients may be seen on a spaceavailable basis; however, services are very limited and it is best to establish primary care at a local Italian clinic.

Medical in-processing occurs every Wednesday during the in-processing briefings. Bring your PCS orders to enroll all dependents in TRICARE.

The TRICARE office is in the clinic: Bldg 121, Area 1, Room GD04.

▶ VICENZA

The U.S. Army Health Clinic at Vicenza treats active-duty soldiers and their dependents while they are stationed at USAG Italy. Civilians, DoDEA employees, contractors and their family members must seek healthcare in the local Italian community.

Medical in-processing briefings occur every other Thursday at 2 p.m. at the Central Processing Facility (CPF), Bldg 393, in classroom 3.

► CAMP DARBY

A small, limited medical clinic on Camp Darby only treats active-duty service members. Patients may be referred to the health clinics in Vicenza or Aviano. Dependents should establish care at a local Italian doctor.

Soldiers will complete medical in-processing during briefings. However, they need to complete TRICARE registration for dependents through International SOS by phone: +44 20-8762-8384.

GIVING BIRTH IN ITALY

Giving birth in an Italian hospital can be a wonderful experience. Before delivery, you can choose which local hospital fits your birthing needs, and you will be able to tour the hospital and meet the staff.

Delivery options

- ► Local Italian hospital.
- At your own expense, and without a TRICARE referral, you may travel to the U.S. If you choose to do this, you will need to remain in the U.S. until the new baby's identification documents are established.

First steps after giving birth:

- ✔ Obtain your baby's Social Security Number
- ✓ Enroll your baby in DEERS
- ✓ Contact local TRICARE
- Get your baby a Command Sponsorship memo.
- ✓ Take passport photos.
- ✓ Get a no-fee U.S. passport.
- ✓ Get a U.S. tourist passport.
- Get a Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA).

DENTAL CARE

Dental care is available to active-duty service members at Aviano and Vicenza. Dependents may be seen, infrequently, on a space-available basis. There is no on-post dental care at Camp Darby. With TRICARE Dental insurance, via United Concordia, patients not seen on installations can establish quality, affordable care at dentists in the local Italian community.



SCHOOL OPTIONS





Your installation School Liaison Officer (SLO) is a good first resource for any questions regarding school options while stationed in Italy. While most students attend a Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) school, both homeschooling and local Italian schools are available.

DoDEA schools accept enrollments throughout the year to accommodate military families.

- Livorno Elementary Middle School: Pre-K to 8th grades.
- High school students wil be registered with the Non-DOD Schools Program (NDSP) which offers funding and assistance so students can attend school at one of five options:
 - 1. Local Italian School
 - 2. Homeschool or online school
 - 3. International School of Florence (ISF)
 - 4. Canadian School of Florence (CSF)
 - 5. A boarding school elsewhere

HOME-SCHOOLING

Homeschooling is a legal option open to all SOFA-sponsored active-duty military, DoD civilians and contractors. Your children may be eligible for auxiliary services offered by DoDEA. Contact your SLO for more information and to connect with homeschool groups.

ITALIAN SCHOOLS

While stationed in Italy, you have the option to send your children to local Italian schools. All instruction will be in Italian, though most schools will offer remedial language acquisition help. Keep in mind that students will not get American holidays off. You will need a local address to enroll. Visit your installation SLO for local school information.

Italian education stages

- Kindergarten: "scuola dell'infanzia" or "Asilo." Ages 3 to 6.
- Primary school or elementary school: "scuola primaria" or "scuola elementare." Ages 6 to 11.
- Lower secondary school or middle school: "scuola secondaria di primo grado" or "scuola media." Ages 11 to 14.
- Upper secondary school or high school: "scuola seconaria di secondo grado" or "scuola superior." Ages 14 to 19. There are three types of high school:
 - **1.** "Liceo" for high-level theoretical study and university preparation.
 - "Istituto tecnico" is the most common, and also leads to a university entrance qualification.
 - "Istituto professionale" is a vocational school for specific trades, crafts and careers.

PM INFORMATION



► AVIANO

Pets must be registered via email with the Aviano Veterinary Treatment Facility within 14 duty days of arrival. The veterinarian is available for pet appointments; however, they do not offer emergency veterinary care. You will need to make an appointment to obtain an EU pet passport.

Contact the clinic for a list of local veterinarians for specialty or emergency "Ambulatoria Veterinario," care.

► VICENZA / CAMP DARBY

Within 10 days of arrival, pets must be registered, in person or via email, with the Army Veterinary Center on Caserma Ederle in Vicenza. Pets may be seen at the clinic. It is necessary to contact the clinic for instructions on obtaining an EU pet passport. Camp Darby does not have a vet clinic.

There is a limit of two pets for families assigned to on-post housing. In addition, certain dog breeds deemed potentially aggressive are prohibited. Exotic or farm animals are also prohibited.

VACCINATIONS

Rabies: Mandatory annual vaccine for both dogs and cats. Rabies tags must be worn at all times.

Leptospirosis: This vaccine is highly recommended for all pets. Leptospirosis bacteria has a heavy presence in Italy and can cause kidney failure.

Heartworm Preventative: Mandatory for dogs and cats.


Flea and tick control: This is highly recommended year-round.

ITALIAN PET REGULATIONS

- Dogs may not be chained for longer than eights hours and must not be unattended.
- Dogs may not be left in a kennel or crate.
- Dogs kept on balconies, in basements or in garages must be able to enter the house on their own.
- · Shelter, food and water must always be provided for your pet.
- While driving, pets cannot interfere with the driver.
- Dogs must be walked: twice daily for apartment residents, once daily for homes with small yards. If the yard is 120 square meters or larger, walking requirements are waved.
- Dog leashes must be less than five feet long. Dog walkers must clean up after their dog and keep a muzzle on hand.
- · Feral cats are protected by Italian law, so consider keeping your house cat inside.
- Dogs, cats and ferrets must have a 15-digit ISOcompliant international microchip.
- Choke chains, pinch collars and shock collars are illegal in Italy and punishable with fines.

TRAVELING WITH YOUR PET

- The EU Pet Passport must be kept with your pet when traveling throughout Europe.
- The passport must list the pet's microchip number that is registered with the installation veterinarian.
- The passport must indicate a valid rabies vaccination is up to date.





As of Jan. 1, 2024 the DoD has enacted a Pet **Transportation Allowance**

There is plenty to do during your tour in Italy! From on-installation employment or education to volunteer work and travel, your time in Italy has a lot to offer.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) does not allow for dependents to work on the economy or operate home-based businesses in Italy. The following are options for on-installation job searching:

- Federal Employment: Non-Appropriated Fund (NAF) and General Schedule (GS) positions are offered with MWR, FSS and command agencies. Hours range from full-time to flexible part-time with varying employment benefits. Search and apply at: usajobs.gov.
- DoDEA-Europe: On-installation schools offer full and part-time employment as support staff, substitute teachers and administrative employees Find certified teaching positions at: dodea.edu/offices/HR. Find local support positions at usajobs.gov





FREE APPS

Google Translate

This app comes in handy when you are exploring new Italian neighborhoods. It allows you to "say" the word in Italian and hear how it is pronounced. You can also turn on the image feature and hover your phone over the Italian text to translate in real-time to English without typing each word.

Duolingo

Duolingo provides you with a pre-test so you can begin your training wherever you are in your Italian learning. It has a gamified technique to help you learn and practice. You learn new words, sentence structure and practice listening and speaking skills. If you are somewhere where you cannot turn up the volume or speak into your phone, you can also opt out of those practices for 15-minute intervals. There are free and premium versions of the app.

ONLINE

 Through Army MWR or USAFE Library websites, you can access Mango Languages to learn Italian for free on your computer or mobile device.

IN PERSON CLASSES

- Corsi Gratuiti Di Lingua E Cultura Italiana
 These free Italian language courses are organized in all provinces by the "Centri Provinciali per Istruzione degli Adulti" (CPIA). These courses occur twice a week and last for an entire school year. They are typically offered at three different times each day (morning, afternoon or evening). The only cost to the student is purchasing the textbook, if they desire. Contact your nearest CPIA office for more information.
- For Army families stationed here in Italy, ACS and MWR offer free or low-cost in-person and hybrid classes.
- For Air Force families, FSS provides low-cost classes.
 Each of these classes typically runs in ten-week
 cycles throughout the year, so there is always one about to start.

GETTO KNOW SACILE & PORDENONE

Many people stationed at Aviano find homes near Sacile and Pordenone. These thriving Italian towns have much to offer and are fun to explore.

SACILE

In the Middle Ages, the garden village of Sacile grew along a trade route that protected the crossing of the Livenza River. At this time, a small shrine was built that would later be replaced with the Duomo di San Nicolo. Inside its typical Venetian architecture are some incredible 15th-century frescoes. The Duomo makes a great starting point for a walk around town. Down the road is the Torrione di Pra Castelvecchio, a portion of the medieval city wall that is tucked into the Giardini Ortazza park that straddles the river. There is a small pedestrian-only bridge that makes a scenic stroll to the other side.

As part of the former Republic of Venice, the town of Sacile became a haven for noble families who built their palaces along the Livenza River. You can see a series of opulent political frescoes by visiting the Palazzo Ragazzoni near the park. Now an event center, the palace courtyard hosts a local market on Thursday mornings.

Crossing back over the river will bring you back to the heart of this scenic village. Many of the restaurants and bars around the Piazza del Popolo have patios that open onto the Livenza River, which seems to surround the town. Sacile's historic center is actually built on two islands within the river. For a quintessentially Italian experience, finish off your day in Sacile by having a drink or tasting some gelato at one of the many riverside terraces.

PORDENONE

The Noncello River that runs adjacent to Pordenone was an important byway during the Middle Ages. After a dock called the Portus Naonis developed on the river's edge, the town grew around it and became an active trading site. It is still a great place to go shopping. The cobblestoned Corso Vittorio Emanuele II, or "Corso" leads north from the river and into the old city center. It is a walking street with plenty of Italian charm. The road is lined with colorful, historic shuttered buildings, outdoor cafes and many local specialty shops.

Elite families residing in Pordenone were an active part of the Italian Renaissance, and their artistic patronage can still be seen in the city's center. Many of the building facades have colorful frescoes or friezes that were restored for the city's "Corso Facades Project" in 1991. One such building is the Palazzo Ricchieri, which now houses the Civic Art Museum. Nearby is the Duomo di San Marco with its stark façade, beautiful bell tower and extensively decorated interior. Across the street is the impressively Gothic Town Hall, which was built in the 1300s.

Take some time along Pordenone's Corso to sit and enjoy the plentiful outdoor cafes. Local food and wine are on show since the town is a member of the Slow Food movement. Try a Friulano or RIbolla wine, a local prosciutto or a cheese and potato pie called a "frico." On Wednesday and Saturday mornings, tents are set up in the area of XX Settembre Square. This City Market is the perfect place to mingle with locals, find some deals and try the local Italian cuisine. ■

EXPLORING THE AVIANO AREA

There is so much to see and do in the Aviano region. Nestled between the Dolomite mountains and the Venetian coast, this area overflows with history, culture and natural beauty.

HISTORY

For local Roman ruins, visit the hamlet of Aquileia, where you can explore the open-air archaeological park and check out the incredible 4th-century floor mosaics in the local basilica. This UNESCO Heritage Site offers a fascinating glimpse of early Christianity within the Roman Empire. Visit fondazioneaquileia.it for details.

There are plenty of hilltop castles around Aviano. Nearby, you can explore the ruins at Polcenigo for a great view of the area. The castle in Conegliano hosts a medieval museum and a restaurant specializing in local, seasonal menus. You can even stay the night inside the crenelated walls of the Castello di Roncade.

CULTURE

In order for a sparkling wine to be labeled Prosecco, it must come from the Conegliano Valdobbiadene region around the Strada Del Prosecco. There are now four routes that make up this Prosecco road, but the main one is a 90 km loop paste vineyards, villages and even vending machines full of wine. For routes and information, check out coneglianovaldobbiadene.it

The canals of Venice are only about an hour away, but after your first visit try venturing to the other island towns in the Venetian Lagoon. Murano is known for its locally blown glass while Burano is known for lace manufacturing. Both have bright, colourful architecture and the canals that make this area so famous.

NATURE

Make your way up into the mountains at nearby Pianca-vallo. In the winter, this small resort town has skiing, snowboarding, sledding and cross-country snow sports. In the summer, you can escape the valley heat, hike in the cool mountains, trek along the via ferrata and enjoy the alpine slide.

Head away from the mountains for some seaside fun at the nearest beaches. The town of Caorle has a cute historic center, a wide swath of sandy beach and a long waterfront promenade full of the shops and cafes that make for a great day at the coast any time of year.



GETTO KNOW VICENZA

Being stationed in Italy is quite an adventure, and there are plenty of chances to experience Italy in the Vicenza area. Vicenza, as a city, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and right in your backyard.

TWICE WEEKLY MARKET: What better way to live like an Italian than to shop at the local market? Every Tuesday and Thursday, the Piazza dei Signori comes alive with vendors selling cheese, sausage, flowers, clothing and more. The Thursday market is bigger than the Tuesday one. No matter which day you go, get there early. Food is often sold out around 1 p.m. and vendors start closing down at 2 p.m.

PIAZZA DEI SIGNORI: Translated as the "Square of the Lords," this elegant place will make you feel like a lord or lady of old. It is home to the aforementioned market as well as many events and shows throughout the year.

RIGHETTI (SELF RESTAURANT RIGHETTI): It's up to you to keep up with your food and drink consumption at this "honest" restaurant in Vicenza. Located inside a 17th-century palace just a few steps from the Piazza dei Signori, enjoy a rotating daily menu of Italian fare. You order directly from the cooks and close at the cashier after the meal.

THE JEWELRY MUSEUM: While in Vicenza you can visit the first jewelry museum in Italy. The two-story museum features 11 exhibition rooms and a bookshop. Kids will enjoy the educational activities, and everyone can enjoy the guided tours. The museum often hosts workshops and family activities.

BASILICA PALLADIANA: Architect Andrea Palladio designed palaces, villas and buildings across Vicenza. The Basilica Palladiana is one of his most famous structures. The basilica was originally a medieval town hall. Today, it houses shops, bars, a walkable roof terrace and the Jewelry Museum. Other Palladio projects in Vicenza include the Teatro Olimpico, Villa Capra 'La Rotonda' and Palazzo Chiericati.

MATTEO GRANDI: For an elegant night out, try the Michelin-starred restaurant, Matteo Grandi, located in the Basilica Palladiana. Enjoy a seasonal four-course menu and select wine from their extensive wine menu.

ROMEO AND JULIET: In a plot that later formed the famous Shakespearean play, Vicenza is the home of the original author of "Romeo and Juliet," or Romeo and Giulietta as they were originally known. Luigi da Porto wrote the story as a novella and it features familiar characters such as Tybalt, Paris, Friar Lawrence, and Mercutio. It was published in 1531 after da Porto had died. You can visit his burial site in Vicenza at the Church of Santa Corona. The famous "fair Verona where we lay our scene" is only 30 minutes down the road. ■



DOWNTHE ROAD FROM VICENZA

Not only do you have the great city of Vicenza at your disposal, but these gems are less than 20 minutes down the road.

DUEVILLE: This small town of less than 15,000 people is a great place to spend the day. Lovers of historical houses will want to visit the Villa Monza. This three-story house, which now serves as a municipal building, is artfully built and decorated and visitors can tour it during opening business hours. The Birreria Alle Poste is a great place to grab a beer near the local swimming pools. For a sweet treat, the Tagliaferro Pasticceria provides tasty pastries and cakes. For a full Italian meal experience, the Buffalo Grill offers patrons pizza, fish, vegetarian, pasta and meat options, so there is something on the menu for everyone.

ALTAVILLA VICENTINA: For a great date night or family fun day, Altavilla Vicentina is the place to go. VKI - Vicenza Kart Indoor, where children as young as seven can drive on the track, is open late into the night daily. Parco "Il Lago" di Altavilla Vicentina (The Lake Park) is a wonderful way to spend the day walking when the weather is nice. Ducks, geeks and swans all nest here and there is 70,000 square meters of area to explore. For a bite to eat, the Antica Trattoria da Nello promises "the traditional cuisine of the Berici Hills," featuring local foods like Vicenza-style cod with polenta brustolà, homemade bigoli al torcio with duck sauce and Scottadito-style lamb chops with polenta.

CALDOGNO: History buffs should check out Villa Caldogno. Construction here began in the mid-1500s and the villa was designed by famed architect, Andrea Palladio. During World War II, it was acquired by the German army for the establishment of "Militar Saniat." Today, you can visit the villa and bunker on the weekends. For a tasty vegan meal in Caldogno, go to Joia and savor the tagliolini with seaweed and pistachio, the vegan black burger or the millefeuille with chocolate chips. They offer traditional Italian cuisine as well, so every appetite will be satisfied.

TORRI DI QUARTESOLO: If you want to spend your day shopping, Torri di Quartesolo is your town. The large Centro Acquisti Le Piramidi is open daily. This three-level mall offers patrons shops, restaurants and services. You can grab a coffee, shop for clothing, jewelry and electronics, pick up your Amazon order, let the kids enjoy the rides and attractions and eat at one of the third-level cafes, all in one day. During the holiday season, check out the Christmas market and get your picture with Santa at Le Piramidi. ■



GETTO KNOW LIVORNO

EXPLORING LIVORNO

Livorno made a name for itself as a cosmopolitan port town during the Renaissance under the guidance of the Medici family. In 1577, it was designed as an "ideal town" by architect Bernardo Buontalenti. He had previously built Livorno's massive Fortezza Vecchia, or old fortress, which you can still see today standing guard on the waterfront. Past the fortress, canals were created to allow for incoming trade ships. There are plenty of local boat owners who dock their vessels along the same canals in the Venezia Nuova District.


The port city came under the watchful eye of Ferdinando I de' Medici, who was the Grand Duke of Tuscany. He gave Livorno special privileges as a "port franco," or free port. This meant that international goods could be traded here without taxes. Soon, the city developed an international and diverse population. The Medici family built an extensive new fort, the Fortezza Nuovo, along the canals on its own huge island. The fort has fallen into disrepair, but it is interesting and free to explore and contains one of Italy's famous protected street cat enclaves.

The Via Grande is the city's main shopping road that stretches from the port to the Piazza della Repubblica. Modern stores and restaurants line the road in shady covered arcades. While you are here, be sure to try some seafood. The Mare Matto stand near the waterfront has delicious budget options and a few chairs for an al fresco experience. Livorno's iconic dish is a mixed seafood stew called cacciucco, and the best is found at Trattoria Da Galileo.

The Livorno waterfront is where the action has always been in this city, and the ever-expanding port continues this heritage. When you are ready to explore further afield, you can get in on the maritime action by taking a ferry from the Porto di Livorno to Corsica, Sardinia or Sicily. The massive ferries are operated by four different companies and offer overnight rooms, car decks and entertainment on longer sailings.

The Cinque Terre



uilt around the 11th century, the five villages of the Cinque Terre were, at one time, only accessible by boat or footpath. Hiking between them is still the best way to discover the lemon trees, olive groves and clusters of multicolored houses in this region. As intriguing as this sounds, I was reluctant to take my 10-month-old there. I heard traveling in the Cinque Terre with children was difficult, but I was not going to be deterred.

MONTEROSSO AL MARE is the

biggest of the five villages and the only one with sandy beaches. It's spread out between the "new town" and the "old town. "New town" boasts a beachfront promenade lined with modern hotels, restaurants and bars. The paths through Monterosso are stroller-friendly with numerous gelato stands and a beachside playground. "Old town" includes restaurants, churches and shops nestled in stone alleyways.

hike or a 10-minute train ride to Vernazza, a narrow, one-street town with a church built on the water. The remains of a castle and old wall

From Monterosso, choose between a two hour

that once protected against pirates and a small harbor lined with colorful fishing boats make this town a must-see. It was an easy trip with my little one and made a great lunch stop.

East of Vernazza is Corniglia. From the train station, it takes 365 steps up the cliff or a long walk on a steep winding road to reach the town center. There is a green park bus you can take to and from the train station; however, the schedules varied and tested the patience of our little one. So, we embraced the vertical challenge and rewarded ourselves with gelato after the climb.

Another one-street town, Manarola is the smallest of the five. It has a small harbor and rocky beach where you can take a swim. Here you can enjoy a unique spot of land from which the most famous Cinque Terre photos are taken.

Riomaggiore has one main street, a harbor, a rocky beach, a castle, a church and a dozen restaurants. It also has good train connections and is the closest to the larger city of La Spezia. This was an easy excursion and quick train ride from Monterosso.

GETTING AROUND

Since the hiking trails vary in difficulty, length and beauty, it is particularly important for families with kids to choose their itineraries carefully.

Train: We found the train to be an excellent way to travel between villages. Kids under age 4 travel free on the TrenItalia trains (both regional and national).

Car: If you are driving to Cinque Terre, few places offer parking, and most villages are closed to vehicle traffic. It's possible to find a central parking lot for a daily fee.

Ferry: Ferries are a great way to get away from the hustle and bustle and are available at most of the villages.

LOCAL CUISINE

The food in this region is best described as fresh, local, homemade cuisine that soothes the soul. Like a lot of kids her age, my daughter tends to be a picky eater. But in the land of pasta, she was an easy customer.

PESTO: This region is the birthplace of pesto. Basil is ground with cheese, garlic, olive oil and pine nuts, and then poured over pasta. My daughter loved the pesto lasagna at La Cantina di Miky in Monterosso. By the end of the trip they knew her name and always had a highchair ready to go.

FOCACCIA: This tasty, fluffy bread, also originates here. It's simply flatbread with olive oil and salt. Try it at Panifacio Focacceria in Vernazza.

TORTA MONTEROSSINA: A wonderful cake named after the village with layers of chocolate and cream. Try Pasticceria Laura in Monterosso. This place became our frequent stop for breakfast. We couldn't get enough of the fresh pastries and cappuccinos.

Any uncertainty I had about taking my daughter to the Cinque Terre was quickly erased. The sweet smell of the sea, stunning views, fantastic food and watching my daughter play with the local kids at the park made the Cinque Terre the perfect family weekend getaway.


