WELCOME TO SIGONELLA

Your Checklist

PRE-ARRIVAL

- ☐ Read and understand your orders. Ask chain of command if you need help.
- Connect with your sponsor. Email sicily-sponsor@eu.navy.mil if you haven't received word from them in two weeks.
- Obtain your tourist passport.(MANDATORY to live on the economy)
- ☐ Dependents: Start visa process.
- ☐ Ensure your U.S. driver's license is valid.

EXTRA NOTES:

- If dependents are delayed due to visa or medical issues, have the losing command process a delayed dependent travel request to ensure you don't have BAH issues upon reporting.
- Consider mobile phone options to retain a U.S. number for two factor authentica tion and continuity. Some carriers require porting prior to departure. See page 8.

ARRIVAL

- If reporting to NASSIG or NASSIG Security, check in with base admin NLT 5 days after arriving in Sigonella.
- ☐ Attend the installation's Base Wide Orientation and Command Indoctrination Brief (INDOC). Email: M-SI-NASSIG-TRAINING-GS@eu.navy.mil, Call +39 095564696
- Report to Housing Office within 48 hours of arrival.
- ☐ Service members/civilians: Get your "codice fiscale" through the Housing Office, Bldg. 319. Call: +39 095-56 4311
- ☐ Dependents: Get your "soggiorno." Visit the Legal Office at NAS II for more information, Call: +39 095-56-5247/5056
- ☐ Ensure no-fee passport has SOFA stamp.
- Obtain a tourist passport if planning to travel outside of Italy.
- Enroll in TRICARE and complete medical in-processing.
- ☐ Sign up for an FPO box, if your sponsor has not already done so.
- Visit Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) for Relocation Assistance and Area Orientation.

MONEY

- Determine allowances with Personal Support Detachment.
- ☐ Withdraw euros.
- ☐ Establish bank account to handle local bills, if necessary.

- $\hfill \square$ Research online bill-pay options.
- Contact U.S. banks to close accounts, as needed.

CARS

- ☐ Schedule driver's exam. See page 14.
- $\hfill \square$ Pass exam and get translated AFI license.
- ☐ Get rental car. Many options at Catania Airport, or on base at NAS II Europcar: https://www.europcar.com/en/stations/ italy/ sigonella-nas-2 Email: it.sm.sigonellanasii@europcar.com Call: +39 095-565468
- When car arrives or is purchased, get insurance, register and pass safety inspection.
- ☐ Establish account with NEX for receiving rationed fuel and oil.
- Obtain international license.

HOUSING

- ☐ Again, report to Housing Office within 48 hours of arrival.
- ☐ Attend Welcome Brief (off-base housing)
- ☐ Visit www.Homes.mil for list of inspected and approved rental homes.
- ☐ Prioritize needs and wants.
- Schedule appointments with approved realtors to tour homes, if desired.
- Select home and sign paperwork after review.
- ☐ TLA approval and OHA processing through the Housing Office
- Establish utility accounts through the Housing Office
- ☐ Sign up for communication services (read contracts *carefully*).
- Coordinate loaner furniture with Housing and utilize Fleet and Family Support Center's loan locker, thrift stores, flea markets and classic needs f or household items while awaiting HHG arrival.
- ☐ Purchase liability and renter's insurance.

MEDICAL

- $\ \square$ Add emergency numbers to cell phone.
- Establish relationships with local medical providers.
- Drop off your medical and dental records at Patient Administration at the hospital on NAS I.

CHILDREN

☐ Have vaccination records, transcripts, PCS orders, passports and birth certificates readily available.

- Begin registration process for DODEA schools.
- Contact School Liaison Officer for information about home referrals and transition assistance.
- ☐ Visit the Child Development Center to apply and get on the waitlist.
- ☐ Ensure vaccinations are current and schedule wellness exams.

PFTS

- ☐ Register pet at the veterinary clinic and with the Housing Office. Only two pets are allowed in Family Housing. No pets in the barracks.
- ☐ Find Italian vet clinic that provides emergency care.
- ☐ Maintain annual rabies vaccinations during overseas tour.
- ☐ Get updated ID tags with local contact information.
- Obtain pet passport for flying with your pet within Europe.
- ☐ Purchase pet insurance, including liability.
- ☐ Purchase flea/tick preventative medication that protects against sand flies that can transmit the Leishmaniasis disease. Use either monthly topical products containing permethrin, or collars containing deltamethrin or flumethrin changed out every six months.
- ☐ Find a boarding center or pet sitter.
- Understand and adhere to local Italian pet laws.

PERSONAL ENRICHMENT

- Update resume and research job/ volunteer opportunities.
- ☐ Visit Navy College to learn about course offerings.

EVERYDAY LIVING

- ☐ Log important phone numbers and program cell phone.
- Start disposing trash and recycling according to local requirements.
- ☐ Learn basic Italian phrases or enroll in language classes on base.
- ☐ Get to know your neighbors.
- ☐ Join spouses' clubs, Italian-American clubs or other activities.
- ☐ Consider the many opportunities MWR provides to explore Sicily.
- ☐ Plan trips to explore Europe with the help of europe.stripes.com ■

▶ Google Voice


Google Voice will allow you to port your U.S. number for a fee so you can keep it. Then, you can use a local SIM card to have a local number and U.S. number simultaneously (with a dual-SIM phone.) Google Voice allows free calls to the U.S. using WiFi. If you don't want to be limited to WiFi

and haven't gotten a local SIM yet, Google Fi is a paid phone plan that uses T-Mobile's cell towers. Starting either of these processes is much easier while still in the U.S.

EURO BANKING



There are options ranging from a credit union, bank or international banking mobile apps to help pay your bills, transfer money, make purchases, get cash and manage funds between U.S. dollars and euros.

Beware of unfavorable exchange rates from these on-installation entities. You can pay bills in euros online through the Wise app with competitive exchange rate and low fees.

ON-INSTALLATION BANKING OPTIONS **Credit Unions**

Credit unions are owned and operated by their members. Members' savings are combined to create a pool of funds from which other members can borrow. Members then reap the rewards of their pooled investment income by gaining lower loan rates, higher savings rates and additional services.

Mobile Apps

These "portable" banks are a great tool to get local bills paid, and often with competitive exchange rates and low fees.

- ▶ Wise: International banking app that you can create a local account to pay rent and bills in Euros.
- ▶ N26: International banking app that you can create a local account to pay rent and bills in Euros.

Banks

CREDIT CARDS

- Many Italian businesses, especially smaller businesses, do not take credit cards.
- Always carry euros when off base.
- ► There are sometimes transaction fees when using credit cards, so make sure you also have cash to avoid paying unnecessary fees.

BEWARE OF FEES


Search on and off the installation for the best ATM exchange rate at a reputable bank. Remember that transaction fees are usually added if you are not a member of the bank.

SHIPPING YOUR VEHICLE OVERSEAS

- Ship your vehicle six to eight weeks before you PCS to ensure it gets there soon after your arrival to Sigonella.
- Decide between selling your other vehicles, keeping them in storage or leaving them with a friend or family member.
- A max of three vehicles are allowed per active-duty member along with their dependents during their tour in Italy.

GETTING YOUR ARMED FORCES ITALY (AFI) LICENSE

Call the Motor Vehicle Registration Office (MVRO) for driver's testing. Be sure to ask about test days and times.

▶ What to bring to get your **AFI license:**

- ✓ Current U.S. driver's license. It is highly recommended that you renew your license so that it does not expire during your tour.
- ✔ PCS orders/DOCPERS MFR (contractors)/Logistical Support Letter (DoD civilians)

INSURANCE

Vehicle insurance for the Sigonella area is expensive and the cost depends on the car's make, model, year and age of the driver. Vehicles shipped at government expense cannot be registered or released for use without proof of valid insurance. On base, there are two options:

- Geico: 095-86927
- USAA: 800-971-707 (toll free in Italy)

BUYING A CAR IN ITALY

You have the option to buy a new or used car from dealers and private sellers in Italy. There is no tax when buying a vehicle from another military member.

Keep in mind

Any vehicle that doesn't meet U.S. specifications (specs) cannot be shipped back to CONUS.

- Used automatic transmission vehicles may be more difficult to find and tend to be more expensive.
- Morale, Welfare and Recreation's (MWR) Auto Skills shop offers a free 30+ point assessment that will tell you everything you need to know before buying or selling a vehicle.

MOTORCYCLES

If you want to ride a motorcycle while in Italy, you must have a motorcycle classification on your U.S. license, have an AFI license, attend a mandatory motorcycle safety course on the installation and be at least 18 years old. Motorcyclists can only operate a motorcycle of 35 kW or less.

VEHICLE INSPECTION

Each vehicle is required to be inspected periodically depending on its age, in addition to every time the title is transferred. Ensure that your vehicle always has the required equipment at all times, not just for its inspection.

► Required equipment for inspection:

- ✓ Vehicle registration
- ✓ First-aid kit, warning triangle and reflective vest

REGISTERING YOUR VEHICLE

Contact the MVRO for vehicle registration days and times.

▶ What to bring to register your vehicle:

- ✔ POV registration application
- ✓ AFI driver's license
- ✔ U.S. license
- ✓ Military ID
- ✓ Shipping document
- ✔ Proof of ownership
- ✔ PCS orders/DOCPERS MFR (contractors)/Logistical support letter (DoD civilians)
- ✔ Funds to cover the registration fee and applicable road tax for a second vehicle to include motorcycles
- ✔ Automobile insurance policy

Note: It's always best to call the Motor Vehicle Registration Office ahead of time to ensure you're bringing all necessary documents.

FUELING YOUR VEHICLE

▶ Tax-Free Fuel Allowance

- A NEX-issued fuel card, which acts as a debit card linked to your personal credit card, allows U.S. and NATO forces to pay for fuel at the current tax-free price at the time of purchase.
- The vehicle's engine size, engine base, horsepower and fuel requirement determine the monthly fuel allowance.
- The NEX administers the fuel card program. You must maintain your insurance, registration, safety inspection and road taxes to continue to receive your allowance.
- If any one of these parameters are not kept current for any of your household's vehicles, you will need to correct the issue and register for a new fuel card.

▶ Where to get gas

- There are no gas stations on U.S. military installations in Italy.
- Only one Italian gas company will accept your fuel card: ENI. Across Italy, there are over 4,000 stations and many near NAS Sigonella.
- Use your fuel card like a debit card at the pump. It is recommended to pre-authorize your card before filling up to ensure your fuel card will be accepted.
- At some stations, attendants will operate the card machines.
- Fill up at "Fai da te" or "Iperself" pumps to avoid paying extra for full service.

OTHER WAYS TO GET AROUND

► Taxis

- · A taxi from Catania to NAS I or NAS II will cost approximately
- It's always wise to agree on the price ahead of time.
- Be sure to have the driver write it down for clarity.

Driving habits in Sicily are considerably different from those in the U.S.

DRIVING IN SICILY

Driving habits in Sicily are considerably different from those in the U.S. While traffic patterns may seem illogical, a closer look reveals that there are distinct rules of the road. Because of the traffic speed and different conventions, staying alert while driving is important. Exercise the same caution driving here as you would in the U.S.

A few notes to driving in Italy:

- · When a car behind you flashes its lights, move to the right lane as soon as it is safe to do so.
- While horn blowing is technically illegal in many Italian cities, it is loosely enforced. Many people blow their horn to signal their approach at an intersection or their intent to pass. Drivers also commonly use their hazard lights to signal danger, especially during slow or stopped traffic.
- The Italian law allows you to overtake traffic to pass.
- Many intersections have no stop lights or traffic control. The vehicle on the right has the right-of-way, unless there is a stop sign.
- Traffic circles or roundabouts are common. When entering a circle, yield to traffic in the circle.
- Drunk driving is an extremely serious offense in Italy. In Italy, a blood alcohol level of 0.05 is positive proof of driving under the influence. If you are under the age of 21 or have been a licensed driver for less than 3 years, the legal limit for alcohol in your system while driving in Italy is 0.00.

NAS Sigonella has zero tolerance for drinking and driving. A BAC of 0.05 and above onboard any NAS Sigonella installation will result in either administrative and/or non-judicial punishment (NJP).

If you experience an emergency on or off-base, call dispatch at +39-095-86-1911. They will send proper assistance. For non-emergencies, call dispatch at +39-095-86-5225.

DRIVING OUTSIDE OF ITALY

Many countries will not recognize a U.S. or AFI driver's license. You will need to get an International Driving Permit (IDP) at least four weeks before traveling outside of Italy. You can apply by mail or in-person at AAA or the AATA, which are the two agencies authorized by the State Department to issue IDPs. ■

It's important to be open-minded as you search for your new home. Italian homes are much different, smaller and older than what you may be used to. Although the outside of an Italian home may seem small, always go in and take a look inside. More often than not, people are surprised with the layout and newer interior of the home.





TYPES OF HOUSING

Government Family Housing

- ► Generally, accompanied service members are mandatorily assigned to government family housing on base, "Marinai", if occupancy is below 92%.
- ► The government covers the expenses of rent and utilities; you will not receive any Overseas Housing Allowance.
- ► Request the e-Welcome Package prior to arrival and work with your assigned sponsor for your unit assignment.
- Inquire with the Housing Office regarding the Door to Door (D2D) program, a program that enables you to move directly into government quarters upon arrival. A Special Power of Attorney for your sponsor is required.

Unaccompanied Housing Facilities

- ▶ Unaccompanied E-1 to E-4 personnel are mandatorily assigned to the Unaccompanied Housing (UH) facilities on the installation.
- Service members will be assigned to their building based on duty location and room availability.
- ► Request the e-Welcome Package prior to arrival and work with your assigned sponsor for your room assignment.
- Inquire with the Housing Office regarding the Door to Door (D2D) program, that enables you to move directly into UH rooms upon arrival.

Economy Housing

- ► Unaccompanied E-5 and above, civilians/contractors and foreign nationals service members are referred to the local community.
- Private homes and landlords are vetted according to established standards by the Housing Office.
- You are responsible for rent and utilities using your Overseas Housing Allowance or Living Quarters Allowance.

Note: It is required to bring your passport to request your "Codice Fiscale" – the equivalent of the U.S. SSN – which is mandatory for any transactions involving housing, utilities, furniture and other large purchases.

Finding Economy (Private) Housing

► Searching Online

- Visit www.homes.mil
- Enter "NAS SIGONELLA" and search the results by location, bedrooms, price, or other amenities.
- Only units found on www.Homes.mil are ready for rent to NAS Sigonella personnel.

Things to Consider:

- Check the site daily as houses will come and go easily especially in August, which is peak PCS season.
- Consider the condition of roads, commute distance, access to amenities and nearby school bus routes when searching for homes.

► Realtor Program

- If planning to live on the economy, you can also utilize the realtor program.
- Approved realtors have background checks, insurance and are licensed to meet Housing Office standards.
- Approved agencies do not charge any fees to the tenants.
- Use of any other agencies, including those on Facebook, is strongly discouraged. Non-approved agencies may charge fees or use misleading practices.

SHOWING TOUR

- Attend the mandatory housing brief before you begin house hunting.
- Make a "wish list" of selected homes and schedule tours through the Housing Office.
- Report to the Housing Office to schedule your tour.

LEASE SIGNING

- Private housing leases must be signed through the Housing Office to receive all housing services, including loaner furniture and OHA.
- ► The lease is based on Italian law, and neither the Housing Office nor the U.S. Navy is a party to the contract.
- Your housing counselor will assist you in the lease negotiation and signing.
- Copies of the lease agreement will be provided to the Housing Office, tenant, and landlord.
- Renters insurance is highly recommended.



- Once the lease is signed, Housing staff will assist with the activation of utilities.
- Utility contracts and bills will be in Italian. Housing staff are available to help customers understand their bill, but English versions of bills/contracts are not provided.
- ► The Housing Office will assist and liaise on behalf of the customer with electric, gas and phone companies available in your area.
- For utility issues, the Housing Office will be your point of contact.

HOUSING ALLOWANCES

Housing allowances are provided to defray the costs of housing for personnel authorized to live in Economy Housing. Personnel can be expected to pay some costs out of pocket. To see what you qualify for, consult with the Housing Office.

Service members:

- ► Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)
- Reimburses temporary quarters costs while searching for a home or waiting for government housing.
- Personnel must get TLA approved through the Housing Office before submitting to their Command.
- Service members must aggressively seek permanent housing, and make every effort to sign a lease within 30 days upon arrival and move within 45 days.
- · To be eligible for reimbursement, service members must continue to go on showing tours throughout the TLA period.
- · Utility activation after signing a lease can take 10-15 days. Personnel must account for this time within the TLA maximum to avoid paying out of pocket.

- Personnel assigned to government quarters should communicate with their sponsor to ensure zero TLA.
- Overseas Housing Allowance (OHA)
- The allowance includes three components: rental allowance, utility allowance, and move-in housing allowance (MIHA).
- Service members in government housing do not receive this allowance.
- The Housing Office will provide an OHA form to start the allowance once personnel sign a lease.
- The rental allowance is a reimbursement for lease costs but is not paid at a flat rate like BAH. This is paid monthly.
- · The utility allowance is a flat rate to be used only for electric, gas, water, garbage and other recurring maintenance costs. It does not include phone, internet, gardening, cleaning, pool maintenance, etc. Some utility charges may appear in your lease, while others may be directly billed from utility companies. Some maintenance costs are the tenant's responsibility.
- The MIHA is a one-time payment to defray the costs of moving. This can fund the cost of items that may not be provided in community housing.
- Personnel can contact their Command to request an advance OHA payment to cover security deposit, first month's rent, or other charges.

Civilians:

- ► Temporary Quarters Subsistence Allowances (TQSA) can be authorized for the reasonable cost of temporary quarters incurred for a period up to three months or a period ending with the signing of a community lease. Any questions about TQSA should be directed to your HRO.
- LQA rates are designed to substantially cover the cost of privately-rented housing to include rent, electricity, gas, fuel and water. Any questions about LQA should be directed to your HRO.

LOANER FURNITURE AND FULL-TOUR FURNISHINGS PROGRAM

► The Housing Office provides furniture, appliances, wardrobes and transformers to eligible personnel living in economy housing or Family Housing. Shipment of major appliances (washer, dryer, refrigerator, stove) is not allowed as they are not compatible with Italian outlets and voltage. The Housing Office will assist in coordinating delivery and pick-up appointments, and schedule appliance

- trouble calls. Tenants must be home for the appointments.
- Consult with the Housing Office to discuss and request items you may need and set a delivery appointment.
- ► Fleet and Family Support Center offers loan locker supplies such as silverware, dishes, pots, pans, coffee machines, etc. Call 624-4291 for more information.

Loaner Furniture

- Tables, beds, chairs, etc. are available for up to 90 days after move-in but before HHG arrive.
- Loaner furniture can be used again for up to 90 days after your HHG pack-out but before the check-out.

Full-tour Furnishings

Includes appliances, transformers and wardrobes and can be kept for the entire tour, from move-in to check-out.

ELECTRONICS AND APPLIANCES



- Government housing includes outlets for both U.S. and Italian voltages.
- For private housing, outlets will be 220v and Italian plug (usually type F or L). All devices wired for 110v will need an adapter to fit the outlet.
- Dual-voltage devices usually will only need the adapter.
- ► Single-voltage devices will need a power converter/transformer. Be careful! Plugging a device into an Italian outlet without the correct power conversion can be dangerous.
- ► The Housing Office will provide eligible personnel transformers for use during your tour. Consider purchasing additional transformers to meet your power needs. Transformers use energy even when no devices are plugged in, so unplug the transformer as much as possible to save money.
- Surge protectors, extension cords and power strips must all match the Italian outlets.
- ► The Housing Office provides a washer, dryer, refrigerator, and microwave. Work with the Housing Office to schedule delivery and pick-up for the appliances.



uring your time in Italy, you're going to need to see a doctor and dentist. Depending on the specialty services

you might require, you may need to be referred off-installation for medical services.

PATIENT LIAISONS

Host-nation patient liaisons act as intermediaries between patients and doctors to help facilitate the best care possible. From assisting with the language barrier and insurance forms, to providing comfort to clients, patient liaisons can help you feel at ease in the medical surroundings.

Getting a patient liaison

▶ The patient liaison program is available through TRICARE (at the hospital). This program is open to all ID cardholders, including non-TRICARE members.

Life for your in Italy

If you've brought your furry friend to Italy, you must register them at the installation's veterinary clinic and the housing office within 10 days of arriving.

GENERAL RULES

Be aware that no pets are allowed in Unaccompanied Housing and only two (2) pets are permitted in Family Housing, which can be cats and/or dogs.

REQUIRED VACCINATIONS AND MEDICINE

- ✓ Leptospirosis: If you haven't already, you need to get your pet a Leptospirosis vaccination as soon as possible. Leptospirosis has a heavy presence in Italy and without proper vaccination, it can cause kidney failures in pets.
- **✓ Rabies:** Both dogs and cats must get an annual rabies vaccination. Pets are required to wear their rabies tags at all times to serve as a visual marker of vaccination status.
- ✓ Heartworm, flea and tick: Ensure your pets are on heartworm preventative as well as flea and tick control medicine year-round. Flea/tick preventatives include either monthly topical products containing permethrin, or collars containing

deltamethrin or flumethrin changed out every six months.

VETERINARY CLINIC

Though the NAS Sigonella veterinarian primarily serves the military working dogs, they do perform limited veterinary services for NAS Sigonella personnel. Call to see availability, otherwise you are encouraged to utilize off-base vet clinics.

ITALIAN VETERINARY CHNICS

Taking your pet to an Italian veterinarian clinic is recommended for emergency and specialty needs for your pet. It is important to register with an Italian veterinary clinic for health issues that go beyond what the base vet clinic can treat. Contact the veterinary clinic for a list of local Italian vet clinics.

ITALIAN PET REGULATIONS

- Animals must never be left tied up and unattended to.
- Pets must be leashed every time you walk them.
- ► Shelter must always be provided for your pet.
- Cats must be kept indoors at all times.
- Food and water must always be easily accessible for your pet.

- ► Every pet must have a 15 digit international microchip. This is also a form of identification if they are ever lost and brought into a vet clinic.
- ► "Choke chain" or pinch collars are illegal in Italy and use of these types of collars is subject to a fine.

TRAVELING WITH YOUR PET

Requirements:

- ✔ All pets must have their 15-digit international microchip.
- ✔ Rabies vaccination must be up to date and given after the international microchip was implanted.
- ✓ EU Pet Passport must be with you and your pet at all times when traveling.
- ✓ Muzzles must be carried (not worn) for all dogs when in public.
- ✔ Animals must be contained while riding in vehicles (carrier or harness).

TRAVELING WITHOUT YOUR PFT

If you plan on traveling while in Italy, there may be trips where your furry friend can't tag along. Once you register your pet at the installation's vet clinic, they can provide a list of local boarding facilities.

ESTABLISH ROUTINES

The importance of routines in child development should not be overlooked. Establishing routines will help children handle the additional emotional and environmental changes as you get settled.

- ► Eat meals on the economy, attend local fests and learn about Italian traditions. Address the differences between life in Italy versus back home, but move conversations in a positive direction. Your children will gain an appreciation for diversity while exploring.
- Enroll your children in Italian lessons, schools or day care.
- ▶ Explore the best of Europe by letting your children assist in trip planning, researching and selecting sites or activities they would enjoy. Take photos and work together to create scrapbooks, photo albums, calendars, collages and other creative projects.

REMAIN IN TOUCH WITH LIFE BACK HOME

While adjusting to everything new, don't forget about life back home. Set regular video chat or phone call dates with family and friends. If your children are allowed online, encourage them to utilize social media and email to stay in touch with friends or have them send postcards from the destinations they visit. Continue the traditions that are important in your family, while creating new ones during your time in Italy.

EXPECT AN ADJUSTMENT PERIOD

Give your children time to process all of the changes, both good and bad, that come with their new environment. Be aware of expat child syndrome, a psychological condition that typically occurs in children ages 10 to 15 and can lead to isolative or unruly behavior.

PARENT SUPPORT

Being a parent isn't always easy, especially when placed in a new environment. Many on-installation and private resources are available for you, such as Fleet and Family Support Center, Morale, Welfare and Recreation or spouses' clubs. Also, look for community websites and social media resources to find support and friendship.



CHILD EDUCATION

Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) school is located on NAS I and educates children from the ages of pre-K through high school. The Sure Start pre-K program gives priority enrollment to children of service members whose rank is E-1 to E-4, GS-1 to GS-4 or NAF-1 or NAF-2. Start communicating early on with DoDEA or the SLO to begin the enrollment process for your school-aged children.

HOME SCHOOLING

Home schooling is a legal option open to all SOFA sponsored active-duty military, DoD civilians and contractors. Your children may be eligible for auxiliary services offered by DoDEA-Europe. Contact the SLO for more information and to connect with home school groups.

CHILD CARE

Many programs are available through Morale Welfare and Recreation (MWR)'s Child and Youth Programs. Note that waitlists are inevitable, so get started early!

- ▶ The Child Development Center (CDC) supports families with childcare for those aged 6 weeks to pre-school age with experiences designed to enhance their social, emotional, cognitive and physical development. The CDC provides age-appropriate programming, offers nutritionally sound meals and is fully accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC).
- School-Age Care (SAC) is available for children aged 5 and in kindergarten through age 12, and provides care before and after school, and a full-day camp during the winter, spring and summer breaks. The SAC

program is aligned with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America and 4-H and is fully accredited by the Council on Accreditation (COA).


- ▶ The Youth Complex is located in Marinai housing and serves as Sigonella's hub for planned youth events. Available to all registered youth ages 11 (and in the 6th grade) 18 (and still in High School), this facility offers activities such as a Cooking Club, Technology Club, Art Club, Smart Girls, Keystone, Torch Club, and Passport to Manhood, as well as excursions into town for activities such as go-karting, paintballing, hiking, kayaking, paddle boarding, snorkeling, and much more. 
Personal. ENRICHMENT

nderstanding the SOFA agreement between the U.S. and Italy will set realistic expectations for career opportunities during your time in Sigonella. The only job opportunities for dependents can be found on the installation, as dictated by the SOFA. Job openings are fairly limited, so it is important to start looking for job opportunities before PCSing and soon after you arrive.







As things start to settle down with your move to Sigonella, it's best to immerse yourself into the culture as soon as you can. It may seem intimidating at first, but with the installation's resources, understanding Italian culture and learning easy Italian phrases — you'll be adjusted in no time!



WELCOME ORIENTATION

During base indoctrination, the FFSC will take you on an intercultural relations trip to the nearby city of Catania and town of Motta Sant'Anastasia. You may stop in a restaurant, grocery store, market or other shops. The goal is to show you the ins and outs of how to order food and drinks, make purchases in stores and embrace the Italian culture overall. Consult with FFSC about other area orientation classes such as the New Spouse Orientation and ICR (Inter-Cultural Relations) Follow Up.

EVERYDAY LIFE IN ITALY

▶ Dining

- Water is served in bottles only: still or sparkling.
- Expect meals to last at least two hours.
- Lunch times are around noon to 2:30 p.m.
- Dinner times start around 7 p.m. and may stay open until midnight.
- Restaurants close between lunch and dinner.
- Be sure to ask for the check.
- · Most times, you pay at the register.

▶ Shopping

- You'll need a 50 cent or 1 euro coin to insert into shopping carts for use.
- Weigh your produce before checking out.

- · Bring reusable bags for your groceries.
- If you forget a bag, you'll need to pay for one at the register.
- Many shops close for "riposo" which tends to take place between 1 and 4 p.m.

Driving

- Italians tend to drive faster and more aggressively than what U.S. drivers are used to.
- Don't attempt to drive like the Italians to keep up with their pace.
- Italians do not consider it rude to tailgate.
 Don't get upset when they're tailgating you however, don't form a habit of trying to tailgate them back.

AMICI PROGRAM

Visit the Fleet and Family Support Center for information on their "Amici" program. This program connects service members—single or with families—to their Italian counterparts. The goal of this program is to bring people with similar life situations together to experience full immersion in Italian culture.



RECYCLING IN ITALY

Recycling is a requirement in Italy. Each town has different trash and recycle pick-up schedules — so be sure to ask your landlord, neighbors or the Housing Office for information.

Items must be placed in clear or semi-transparent bags. Black trash bags will not be accepted for any items. Do not mix different types of items in the same bag.







Day Trip from Sigonella Charming Catania

Catania traces its earliest history back to the year 729 B.C., when Greeks who had already settled to the north founded Katane.

Through the years, the city in the shadow of Mount Etna has alternately prospered and met devastation. An earthquake in 1169 led to thousands of deaths, and another in 1693 destroyed much of the city. Catania owes its unique present-day appearance to 18th century reconstruction in a Baroque style making extensive use of lava rock. With a population of around 310,000 today it's Sicily's second-largest city after Palermo and can be enjoyed in one day.

Catania Cathedral

Dating back to close to a millennium is Saint Agatha's Cathedral, named in honor of a teenage girl of high birth who underwent many horrific tortures for refusing to recant her Christian beliefs and was martyred in 251. Destroyed by the 1693 earthquake and reconstructed in the mid-18th century, the cathedral's most impressive sights include its striking gray and white lava and limestone façade, a medieval Roman sarcophagus containing the ashes of Aragonese kings and in the sacristy, a portrayal of the 1669 eruption of Mount Etna. From Feb. 3-5 each year, the city's patron saint is venerated as part of one of the largest religious festivals in all Sicily. The bust of Saint Agatha and her relics are placed in an ornate cart which is pulled through town by her devotees.

Fontana dell'Elefante

The city's most charming monument is found on the Piazze del Duomo, where an elephant carved of black lava appears to wear a smile on its face. Nicknamed Liotru by the locals, he's one of the most recognizable symbols of the city. Mystery and legend surrounds the elephant's origins. One story holds the statue was the work of an 8th century nobleman who turned to the making of idols. The statue was restored by famed architect Giovanni Battista Vaccarini between 1735 and 1737, who added an Egyptian-styled obelisk to the elephant's back. As to why the elephant's trunk points directly to the Cathedral of Saint Agatha is another matter of speculation, with some suggesting its magical powers could shield the city from the eruptions of Mount Etna.

La Pescheria Market

For fresh fish and foods of all kinds, head to this market where all manner of sea creatures and fresh food await purchase and transformation into a tasty meal. Nearby seafood restaurants offer a mouth-watering selection of squid, tuna and sea bass along with a variety of shellfish. Osteria Antica Marina, smack-dab in the middle of the market, is popular with locals and tourists alike.

Via Etnea

The city's main shopping drag runs from Piazza del Duomo to the foothills of the mountain for which it takes its name. By day, it buzzes with shoppers in search of the latest fashions or a bargain too good to pass up, while in the evening hours, strollers enjoying their "passeggiata," leisurely-walk, are out in force. Serving as an oasis to all that is the Giardino Bellini, where shaded benches invite travelers to rest their weary feet. Just across from this pleasant park is found the Pasticceria Savia, known for its rendition of the shaved ice dessert, "granita," as well as the fast food that's been around for centuries and the topic of our last tip.

A famous street food

One of the stars of Catania's informal dining scene is the "arancino," a conical ball of rice that's been breaded and fried. Its most typical filling is ragu, a tomato, meat and pea sauce, but other variations are popular as well, to include eggplant (these are called Norma), mushrooms, sausage and pistachio. This Sicilian staple is the topic of a longstanding language dispute. While residents on the eastern side of the island use the masculine form of its name, ending with an "o," Sicilians to the west refer to it in the feminine, "arancina."



Enjoy Roman Villas, Agrigento and Turkish Steps

Now that the jetlag has worn off, newcomer's orientation has been completed and you're down to a handful of sealed boxes in the maelstrom of paper and cardboard, why not take a break and hit the road? One of the best things about exploring an island is if you get lost, you'll eventually find your way back home. Full of rich history, spectacular views and, delicious food, Sicily is the perfect place to explore. Grab your keys and discover these amazing spots in your new backyard.

Piazza Armerina and Villa **Romana del Casale**

(1 hour, 20 minutes)

Approximately 75 kilometers west of Sigonella, in the heart of the island is Piazza Armerina. With an imposing Duomo piercing the skyline, it's worth exploring the narrow alleys leading up to the impressive cathedral. Enjoy a cappuccino and cornetto from a sidewalk cafe before jumping back in the car and heading a few more kilometers east.

A short 15-minute jaunt from Piazza Armerina are the impressive remains of an ancient Roman getaway, Villa Romana del Casale. First excavated in the 19th century, more than 3,500-square-meters of exquisitely detailed mosaic flooring has been unearthed. A designated UNESCO World Heritage Site, the villa is thought to date back to the Imperial Age, at the height of the Roman Empire. Columns

and crumbling walls outline the exterior of the villa. Although the area was subject to devastating flooding and mudslides in the 11th century, the mosaics and floors survived without much damage.

Agrigento

(1 hour, 40 minutes from Villa Romana del Casale)

Once you've explored the remnants of the beautiful villa, hop back in the car and drive through the scenic Sicilian countryside toward the southwestern shore to the city of Agrigento. Nestled on a hilltop overlooking the sea, at first glance, the town doesn't look like much. Resembling a concrete jungle from the outset, the city center is home to a beautiful Medieval town center. Harkening back to its history as a wealthy Greek colony, the influence of Greek culture can be seen and felt around every corner—including just down the road at the Valley of the Temples.

Just a mere 3 kilometers south of Agrigento is one of Sicily's most-visited attractions, Valle dei Templi, or Valley of the Temples. The behemoth archeological site lies on the prehistoric city of Akragas. Visitors can explore the Temple of Concordia, which is surprisingly intact with imposing columns rising around 17-meters tall. Other temples include Temple of Heracles, Juno, Asclepius and more. Visitors can also stroll through the lush olive and citrus groves which took root in an ancient Greek swimming pool.

Scale dei Turchi and Realmonte


(20 minutes from Agrigento)

The Turkish Steps, or Scala dei Turchi, are steeped in rich pirate lore. As local legends recall, Turkish pirates would anchor their ships off the coast, which were hidden due to the step. They would use the naturally formed stairs to sneak into the villages atop the cliff, and carry out their plundering and pillaging before retreating back to their ships.

Nowadays, the Turkish Steps draw curious tourists and sunbathers. From afar, the stairs look as though they've been molded out of clay. Created over centuries due to erosion, wind and rain, the brilliant white hue of limestone and marl is a breathtaking contrast to the jeweltoned turquoise and blue water below. Golden, sandy beaches surround the steps on either side of the cliff.

If the steps are a bit crowded, or you've had your fill of vitamin D for the afternoon, head into the nearby town of Realmonte. Home to one of the most unique churches in Sicily, descend into a halite mountainside to discover the Church of the Realmonte Salt Mine. The "Cathedral of Salt" is carved entirely out of salt, including the crucifix, altar and bishop's seat. Nearby above ground, are the remains of an 1,800-year-old Roman villa. Discovered in the early 20th century, the once opulent home covers more than 5,000-square meters. Intricate mosaic floors and marble have been uncovered, along with columns and collapsing wall remnants distinguish rooms from one another.

With a fascinating and vibrant history, Sicily is home to jaw-dropping historical sites, post-card-worthy panoramas and amazing culture. While it can be tempting to stay inside your comfort zone, there's a fantastic world waiting for you. Grab your sunscreen and explore the beautiful host country around you.





From the towering mountains in the northern Tyrol region to the glittering ocean beaches on the southern islands, Italy is truly a stunning and vast country. Start your Italian adventure close to home and make your way across Sicily to the northwestern side of the island to Marsala, the perfect location for a long weekend.

arsala packs a punch with a plethora of things to see and do. Start in the center of the town at Piazza della Repubblica, the main square. Your eyes will be drawn to the Chiesa de San Tommaso. This cathedral was built around 1176 and features a Baroque façade with two bell towers. Inside you'll find ornate statues, a marble altar and baptismal font, religious art and a large organ. Next, wander towards Palazzo VII Aprile, the city council palace. It was completed in the 15th century and now features a large clock with Roman numerals and a bell.

Then, head to Porta Garibaldi, a large arch that opens into the town. It is part of the remains of what was once a complex defensive system of walls and gates. This is where Giuseppe Garibaldi and the Thousand entered the city in 1860 and began the unification of Italy. The arch features intricate stonework with Latin inscriptions and inlets with statues.

After you've explored the town, get ready for some fabulous food and wine at Baglio Oneto. Plan for a relaxing afternoon of wine tasting and touring this family estate. Begin your

journey at the source of all the goodness, the vineyard. Carry on to the milestone room where the grapes were pounded by foot! Stop at the manor house and then make your way to the grand finale, the wine cellar. Take your time sampling various wines while you enjoy Sicilian cheeses, salami and biscotti. Next, get ready to indulge in some seriously good food.

The restaurant on-site, La Calandra, proclaims they offer "a renaissance for all the senses."

See the beautiful interior with gabled ceilings and exposed wooden beams, or sit on the patio and dine al fresco and look out over the sea. Smell the Mediterranean cuisine with fresh herbs as it is lovingly prepared in the kitchen. Finally, taste the masterpieces from the chef! Meals like blue Egadi fish or the famous red prawns are sure to tickle your fancy. After a tranquil end to your day, head back to your lodging to rest up for the next day's adventures.


On your second day, get ready for some sightseeing in the village of Erice, which you may have heard of before. The ancient Roman poet Virgil talked about it in his Latin epic poem, "The Aeneid." Erice is known as the city with a hundred churches, which is of course, a gross exaggeration. Plan on taking the hiking trail to three churches, known as Porta Castellammare. Here you'll have a fantastic view of the Gulf of Bonagia and you'll see the St. Maria Maddalena, St. Ippolito and St. Maria Maggiore churches.


Next up is Venus Castle. It was built in the 12th century by Normans and stands as a reminder of the goddess of fertility. The castle is built into the cliff-side and features a defensive system of towers. Don't miss out on touring the beautiful gardens, where you can have a panoramic view of the area.

On your way back to Marsala, stop at the salt flats of Trapani. This incredibly unique and unexpected attraction is where salt has been harvested since the 12th century. Piles of salt can be found sitting on a network of "roads" over the shallow water. Windmills dot the landscape and were once used to grind the salt. Though little salt is produced there currently, it still remains a fascinating location. If you have time, rent a canoe and row out into the marshes.

On the last day of your trip, spend the morning at Isola Favignana. There is a multitude of caves and rock formations to explore on this small island off the coast of Marsala. Either scuba dive, snorkel or take a boat around the area. On your way back to Sigonella, make a pit stop in Selinunte to check out the ruins. Though you likely haven't heard of this fascinating location, it is home to the largest archeological site in Europe! Here you'll find temples, an acropolis and other various Greek ruins high up on a plain overlooking the ocean.

Marsala is just one of the many beautiful places to visit in Sicily. Make time to explore the region and learn about its thrilling history. Visit a church or five, lounge on the beach and learn a few things about civilization's past. This is just the beginning of many Italian adventures to come!






